



## **GENERAL NOTES**



- USE PORTABLE WORK ZONE SIGNS ONLY WITH PORTABLE WORK ZONE SIGN STANDS SPECIFICALLY DESIGNED FOR ONE ANOTHER. PORTABLE WORK ZONE SIGNS MAY BE ROLL UP OR APPROVED COMPOSITE.
