General:

The conflicting facilities of these concerns will be adjusted prior to the date of availability, unless otherwise noted and are therefore listed in these special provisions for the benefit of the Contractor. All utility work listed herein will be done by the utility owner. All utilities are shown on the plans from the best available information.

The Contractor's attention is directed to Article 105-8 of the Standard Specifications.

Utilities Requiring Adjustment:

- A) Brunswick Electric Membership Corporation Power (Transmission and Distribution)
- See Utilities By Others Plans for Details. All work to be completed by June 15, 2007.
- B) Atlantic Telephone Membership Corporation Telephone
- See Utilities By Others Plans for Details. All work to be completed by April 26, 2007.
- C) BellSouth Telephone
- See Utilities By Others Plans for Details. All work to be completed by April 26, 2007.
- D) Time Warner Cable Television
- Time Warner's existing buried facilities will remain in place and be adjusted if necessary. If adjustment is necessary, the contractor will notify Time Warner two (2) weeks prior to the date that they are to begin work and allow the owner two (2) weeks to complete the work.

## (E) Town of Oak Island - Wastewater Collection System

• The Town of Oak Island shall install a sanitary sewer collection system consisting of vacuum gravity lines, force main lines, steel encasement pipe and service lines to valve pit locations within the limits of construction.
