



PROJECT SPECIAL PROVISIONS
Utility Construction

All proposed utility construction shall meet the applicable requirements of the NC Department of Transportation's "Standard Specifications for Roads and Structures" dated July 2006. Division 15 of the Standard Specifications is revised as follows:

Page 15-1, Paragraph 4

Provide access for Department personnel and the owner's representatives to all phases of construction. Notify Department personnel and the utility owner two weeks prior to commencement of any work and one week prior to service interruption. Keep utility owner's representatives informed of work progress and provide opportunity for inspection of construction and testing. *The water lines on this project belong to Davidson Water, Incorporated and the City of Lexington. The owner's representatives are Mr. Robert Walters with Davidson Water, Incorporated who can be reached by telephone at (336) 731-2341, and Mr. Rick Comer with the City of Lexington who can be reached by telephone at (336) 248-3930.*

UTILITIES BY OTHERS

General:

The following utility companies have facilities that will be in conflict with the construction of this project.

- A) City of Lexington – Electric Dept. (Distribution)
- B) LexCom - Telephone
- C) MCI – Telephone
- D) City of Lexington – Gas Dept.

The conflicting facilities of these concerns will be adjusted prior to the date of availability, unless otherwise noted and are therefore listed in these special provisions for the benefit of the Contractor. All utility work listed herein will be done by the utility owner. All utilities are shown on the plans from the best available information.

The Contractor's attention is directed to Article 105-8 of the Standard Specifications.

Utilities Requiring Adjustment:

- A) City of Lexington – Electric Dept. (Distribution)

- B) LexCom - Telephone
