To Whom It May Concern:

Reference is made to the Sketch maps and proposal form recently furnished to you on this project.

The following revisions have been made to the proposal:

On Page No. 1, the Project Special Provision entitled "Intermediate Contract Time Number 1 and Liquidated Damages" was revised to indicate that it only applies to NC-109. Please void Page No. 1 in your proposal and staple the revised Page No. 1 thereto.

On Page No. 1 of the Item Sheets, by copy of this addendum, the quantity for Line Item "3-133000000-E-607 Incidental Milling" has been reduced from 746 SY to 570 SY. Also, on Page No. 1 of the Item Sheets, by copy of this addendum, the following new pay item is hereby added: 14-1297000000-E-607 Milling Asphalt Pavement 1.5" Depth (Quantity = 11, 875 SY). The Contractor's bid must be based on these revised pay item quantities.

The following revisions have been made to the sketch maps:

On Sheet Nos. 5 and 6 the Typical Sections and Summary of Quantities have been revised to reflect the above noted quantity change and pay item addition. Please void Sheet Nos. 5 and 6 in your sketch maps and replace with the revised Sheet Nos. 5 and 6.

GENERAL

CONTRACT TIME AND LIQUIDATED DAMAGES:

(7-1-95)(Rev. 12-18-07)

RG 10

The date of availability for this contract is March 31, 2008.

The completion date for this contract is **November 15, 2008**.

Except where otherwise provided by the contract, observation periods required by the contract will not be a part of the work to be completed by the completion date and/or intermediate contract times stated in the contract. The acceptable completion of the observation periods that extend beyond the final completion date shall be a part of the work covered by the performance and payment bonds.

The liquidated damages for this contract are Four Hundred Dollars (\$400.00) per calendar day.

INTERMEDIATE CONTRACT TIME NUMBER 1 AND LIQUIDATED DAMAGES

(2-20-07)

RG 14 A

The Contractor shall complete the required work of installing, maintaining, and removing the traffic control devices for lane closures and restoring traffic to the existing traffic pattern. The Contractor shall not close or narrow a lane of traffic on MAP #1 (NC109) during the following time restrictions:

DAY AND TIME RESTRICTIONS

MONDAY THRU FRIDAY 6:00 A.M. TO 9:00 A.M. MONDAY THRU FRIDAY 4:00 P.M. TO 6:00 P.M.

In addition, the Contractor shall not close or narrow a lane of traffic on MAP #1 (NC109), detain and/or alter the traffic flow on or during holidays, holiday weekends, special events, or any other time when traffic is unusually heavy, including the following schedules:

HOLIDAY AND HOLIDAY WEEKEND LANE CLOSURE RESTRICTIONS

- 1. For **unexpected occurrence** that creates unusually high traffic volumes, as directed by the Engineer.
- 2. For New Year's Day, between the hours of 4:00 p.m. December 31st and 9:00 a.m. January 2nd. If New Year's Day is on a Friday, Saturday, Sunday or Monday, then until 9:00 a.m. the following Tuesday.
- 3. For Easter, between the hours of 4:00 p.m. Thursday and 9:00 a.m. Monday.
- 4. For Memorial Day, between the hours of 4:00 p.m. Friday and 9:00 a.m. Tuesday.
