PROJECT SPECIAL PROVISIONS

GENERAL

CONTRACT TIME AND LIQUIDATED DAMAGES:

(7-20-99) (Rev. 12-18-07)

SP1 G04

The date of availability for this contract is **December 1, 2008**, except that work in jurisdictional waters and wetlands shall not begin until a meeting between the DOT, Regulatory Agencies, and the Contractor is held as stipulated in the permits contained elsewhere in this proposal. This delay in availability has been considered in determining the contract time for this project.

The completion date for this contract is **June 1, 2010**.

Except where otherwise provided by the contract, observation periods required by the contract will not be a part of the work to be completed by the completion date and/or intermediate contract times stated in the contract. The acceptable completion of the observation periods that extend beyond the final completion date shall be a part of the work covered by the performance and payment bonds.

The liquidated damages for this contract are **Eight Hundred Dollars** (\$800.00) per calendar day.

INTERMEDIATE CONTRACT TIME NUMBER 1 AND LIQUIDATED DAMAGES: SP1 G14 B

The Contractor shall not narrow or close a lane of traffic on Riverview St. (SR 1323) and Bryson City Road. (NC 28), detain and /or alter the traffic flow on or during holiday weekends, special events, or any other time when traffic is unusually heavy, including the following schedules:

HOLIDAY AND HOLIDAY WEEKEND LANE CLOSURE RESTRICTIONS

- 1. For unexpected occurrence that creates unusually high traffic volumes, as directed by the Engineer.
- 2. For New Year's Day, between the hours of 4:00 p.m. December 31st and 9:00 a.m. January 2nd. If New Year's Day is on a Friday, Saturday, Sunday or Monday, then until 9:00 a.m. the following Tuesday.
- 3. For Easter, between the hours of 4:00 p.m. Thursday and 9:00 a.m. Monday.
- 4. For Memorial Day, between the hours of 4:00 p.m. Friday and 9:00 a.m. Tuesday.
- 5. For Independence Day, between the hours of 4:00 p.m. the day before Independence Day and 9:00 a.m. the day after Independence Day.

Page 1-93 Subarticle 109-8, add the following:

The base index price for DIESEL #2 FUEL is \$ 3.3926 per gallon.

Where any of the following are included as pay items in the contract, they will be eligible for fuel price adjustment.

UTILITY CONFLICTS:

General:

The following utility companies have facilities that will be in conflict with the construction of this project:

- A. Duke Power Power Transmission/Distribution
- B. Verizon Telephone
- C. Mediacom CATV
- D. Toccoa Natural Gas Natural gas

The conflicting facilities of these concerns will be adjusted prior to the date of availability, unless otherwise noted and are therefore listed in these special provisions for the benefit of the Contractor. All utility work listed herein will be done by the utility owners. All utilities are shown on the plans from the best available information.

The Contractor's attention is directed to Article 105.8 of the Standard Specifications.

Utilities Requiring Adjustment:

- A. Duke Power Power Transmission/Distribution Will not be relocated by the date of availability
 - 1. See "Utility By Others Plans" for utility conflicts.
- B. Verizon Telephone Relocate aerial line and buried telephone facilities to new utility poles by November 1, 2008.
 - 1. See "Utility By Others Plans" for utility conflicts.
- C. Mediacom CATV Relocate to the new utility poles by November 1, 2008.
 - 1. See "Utility By Others Plans" for utility conflicts.
- D. Toccoa Natural Gas Natural gas They will relocate as necessary around the drainage.
 - 1. See "Utility By Others Plans" for utility conflicts.
