GENERAL

CONTRACT TIME AND LIQUIDATED DAMAGES:

(7-1-95)(Rev. 12-18-07)

RG 10

The date of availability for this contract is November 30, 2009.

The completion date for this contract is **November 1, 2010**.

Except where otherwise provided by the contract, observation periods required by the contract will not be a part of the work to be completed by the completion date and/or intermediate contract times stated in the contract. The acceptable completion of the observation periods that extend beyond the final completion date shall be a part of the work covered by the performance and payment bonds.

The liquidated damages for this contract are Eight Hundred Dollars (\$800.00) per calendar day.

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PROJECT SPECIAL PROVISIONS

ROADWAY

SHOULDER CONSTRUCTION:

(12-21-99) (Rev.7-18-06)

R1 R04

Description

The work covered by this provision consists of performing shoulder construction in accordance with Section 560 of the 2006 Standard Specifications and the details of this provision. Construction of a new shoulder is required due to widening of the existing paved shoulder and resurfacing on the existing roadway. Place earth material along the completed edge of pavement and construct shoulders as shown on the sketch map and/or as directed by the Engineer. Backfill and compact the area to the satisfaction of the Engineer. Perform this work immediately after the resurfacing operations are completed as directed by the Engineer.

Materials

Use all suitable material generated from the widening operation to construct the shoulders. Furnish any other earth material necessary for the construction of the shoulders. Provide earth material meeting the approval of the Engineer. No testing will be necessary.

Measurement and Payment

Shoulder Construction will be measured and paid for as the actual number of shoulder miles that have been constructed. Measurement will be made along the surface of each shoulder and to the nearest 0.01 of a mile. Such price and payment will be full compensation for furnishing earth material, hauling, placing, compaction, and all incidentals necessary to complete construction of the shoulders. Seeding and Mulching will be paid for as provided elsewhere in this contract.

Revise the 2006 Standard Specifications as follows:

Page 6-2, Article 600-9 Measurement and Payment, delete the second paragraph.

Page 6-12, Subarticle 609-5(C)2, Required Sampling and Testing Frequencies, first partial paragraph at the top of the page, delete last sentence and add the following:

If the Engineer allows the mix to remain in place, payment will be made in accordance with Article 105-3.
