PROJECT SPECIAL PROVISIONS

GENERAL

CONTRACT TIME AND LIQUIDATED DAMAGES:

(7-20-99) (Rev. 12-18-07)

SP1 G04

The date of availability for this contract is **November 29, 2010**, except that work in jurisdictional waters and wetlands shall not begin until a meeting between the DOT, Regulatory Agencies, and the Contractor is held as stipulated in the permits contained elsewhere in this proposal. This delay in availability has been considered in determining the contract time for this project.

The completion date for this contract is **September 15, 2013**.

Except where otherwise provided by the contract, observation periods required by the contract will not be a part of the work to be completed by the completion date and/or intermediate contract times stated in the contract. The acceptable completion of the observation periods that extend beyond the final completion date shall be a part of the work covered by the performance and payment bonds.

The liquidated damages for this contract are Two Thousand Dollars (\$2,000.00) per calendar day.

INTERMEDIATE CONTRACT TIME NUMBER 1 AND LIQUIDATED DAMAGES: (2-20-07) SP1 G14 A

The Contractor shall complete the required work of installing, maintaining, and removing the traffic control devices for lane closures and restoring traffic to the existing **or new** traffic pattern. The Contractor shall not close or narrow a lane of traffic **according to** the following time restrictions:

DAY AND TIME RESTRICTIONS

Western Boulevard
Monday through Friday from 5:30 A.M. to 8:00 P.M.

Marine Boulevard
Monday through Friday from 5:30 A.M. to 8:00 P.M.

In addition, the Contractor shall not close or narrow a lane of traffic on **any roadway**, detain and/or alter the traffic flow on or during holidays, holiday weekends, special events, or any other time when traffic is unusually heavy, including the following schedules:

HOLIDAY AND HOLIDAY WEEKEND LANE CLOSURE RESTRICTIONS

1. For **unexpected occurrence** that creates unusually high traffic volumes, as directed by the Engineer.



settlement gauge pipe damaged or destroyed due to fault or negligence on the part of the Contractor at no additional cost. No additional payment will be made for compaction of fill around and over the settlement gauges or for interference with the Contractor's operations resulting from settlement gauge installations. Perform installation operations such that the 2" minimum \emptyset pipe remains plumb.

Provide ASTM A53 type F 2" minimum ø pipe, threaded with a black finish.

Assistance for Hydraulic Settlement Gauges

When installing conventional settlement gauges, assist the Engineer in installing hydraulic gauges. Inform the Engineer at least two days before installing settlement gauges

Dig a hole into natural ground three feet deep and three feet square within 10 feet of each conventional settlement gauge location. Dig a trench at least two feet deep and two feet wide from the hole to a location chosen by the Engineer, but not more than 150 feet from the settlement gauge. Grade the trench upward from the hole to the reservoir without excessive undulations.

After the Engineer installs the gauges, backfill the trench before doing any other work in the vicinity.

After installation, take all precautions to protect the hydraulic settlement gauge from damage during construction.

Measurement and Payment


Embankment Settlement Gauges will be measured as the actual number that have been incorporated into the completed and accepted work and will be paid for at the contract unit price per each. Such price and payment will be full compensation for all materials, labor, equipment and other incidentals necessary to complete the work satisfactorily.

Assistance for installing hydraulic gauges will be incidental to installing the conventional gauges.

Select Granular Material used shall be in accordance with Section 265 of the Specifications except that Class II Select Material shall not be used. Payment will be made at the contract unit price per cubic yard for "Select Granular Material, Class III".
