The Contractor may use cation exchange capacity (CEC) values from proposed site borings to plan and develop the bid for the project. CEC values exceeding 15 milliequivalents per 100 grams of soil may indicate a high potential for turbidity and should be avoided when dewatering into surface water is proposed.

No additional compensation for monitoring borrow pit discharge will be paid.

**BORROW MATERIAL:**

Borrow material must meet the general specifications for Class III, Type 2 (A-3 soils only), as defined in Section 1016-3 of the Standard Specifications. Borrow material must also be compatible with existing soil material within the right of way of the project.

The Contractor must collect and submit samples of existing soil material and proposed borrow source(s) for laboratory testing and provide laboratory test reports to the Engineer verifying compatibility.

Final approval of borrow material will be at the discretion of the Engineer.

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
