GENERAL

CONTRACT TIME AND LIQUIDATED DAMAGES:

(7-1-95)(Rev. 12-18-07)

The date of availability for this contract is March 5, 2012.

The completion date for this contract is August 17, 2012.

Except where otherwise provided by the contract, observation periods required by the contract will not be a part of the work to be completed by the completion date and/or intermediate contract times stated in the contract. The acceptable completion of the observation periods that extend beyond the final completion date shall be a part of the work covered by the performance and payment bonds.

The liquidated damages for this contract are Eight Hundred Dollars (\$800.00) per calendar day.

INTERMEDIATE CONTRACT TIME NUMBER 1 AND LIQUIDATED DAMAGES

(2-20-07)

RG 14 A

The Contractor shall complete the required work of installing, maintaining, and removing the traffic control devices for lane closures and restoring traffic to the existing traffic pattern. The Contractor shall not close or narrow a lane of traffic on **ANY MAPS** during the following time restrictions:

DAY AND TIME RESTRICTIONS

MONDAY THRU SUNDAY SUNSET TO 9:00 A.M.

In addition, the Contractor shall not close or narrow a lane of traffic on **ANY MAPS**, detain and/or alter the traffic flow on or during holidays, holiday weekends, special events, or any other time when traffic is unusually heavy, including the following schedules:

HOLIDAY AND HOLIDAY WEEKEND LANE CLOSURE RESTRICTIONS

- 1. For **unexpected occurrence** that creates unusually high traffic volumes, as directed by the Engineer.
- 2. For New Year's Day, between the hours of 9:00 a.m. December 31st and SUNSET January 2nd. If New Year's Day is on a Friday, Saturday, Sunday or Monday, then until SUNSET the following Tuesday.
- 3. For Easter, between the hours of 9:00 a.m. Thursday and SUNSET Monday.
- 4. For Memorial Day, between the hours of 9:00 a.m. Friday and SUNSET Tuesday.

5. For **Independence Day**, between the hours of **9:00 a.m.** the day before Independence Day and **SUNSET** the day after Independence Day.

If **Independence Day** is on a Friday, Saturday, Sunday or Monday, then between the hours of **9:00 a.m.** the Thursday before Independence Day and **SUNSET** the Tuesday after Independence Day.

- 6. For Labor Day, between the hours of 9:00 a.m. Friday and SUNSET Tuesday.
- 7. For **Thanksgiving Day**, between the hours of **9:00 a.m.** Tuesday and **SUNSET** Monday.
- 8. For **Christmas**, between the hours of **9:00 a.m.** the Friday before the week of Christmas Day and **SUNSET** the following Tuesday after the week of Christmas Day.

Holidays and holiday weekends shall include New Year's, Easter, Memorial Day, Independence Day, Labor Day, Thanksgiving, and Christmas. The Contractor shall schedule his work so that lane closures will not be required during these periods, unless otherwise directed by the Engineer.

The time of availability for this intermediate contract work shall be the time the Contractor begins to install all traffic control devices for lane closures according to the time restrictions listed herein.

The completion time for this intermediate contract work shall be the time the Contractor is required to complete the removal of all traffic control devices for lane closures according to the time restrictions stated above and place traffic in the **existing** traffic pattern.

The liquidated damages are One Thousand Dollars (\$ 1,000.00) per hour.

INTERMEDIATE CONTRACT TIME NUMBER 2 AND LIQUIDATED DAMAGES

The Contractor shall complete all work on MAP 2 and shall place and maintain traffic on same.

The date of availability for this intermediate contract time is June 18, 2012.

The completion date for this intermediate contract time is August 17, 2012.

The liquidated damages for this intermediate contract time are **One Thousand Dollars** (\$1,000.00) per calendar day.

PROSECUTION OF WORK:

(7-1-95) RG 15

The Contractor will be required to prosecute the work in a continuous and uninterrupted manner from the time he begins the work until completion and final acceptance of the project. The Contractor will not be permitted to suspend his operations except for reasons beyond his control or except where the Engineer has authorized a suspension of the Contractor's operations in writing.

In the event that the Contractor's operations are suspended in violation of the above provisions, the sum of \$800.00 will be charged the Contractor for each and every calendar day that such suspension takes place. The said amount is hereby agreed upon as liquidated damages due to extra engineering and maintenance costs and due to increased public hazard resulting from a suspension of the work. Liquidated damages chargeable due to suspension of the work will be additional to any liquidated damages that may become chargeable due to failure to complete the work on time.

The base index price for DIESEL #2 FUEL is \$2.9379 per gallon.
