Revise the 2006 Standard Specifications as follows:

Utility Owners' Contact Information:

Page 15-1, Subarticle 1500-2 Cooperation with the Utility Owner, paragraph 2, add the following sentences:

The North Lenoir Water Corporation is owner of the water facilities. The Contractor must contact owner 48 hours in advance of construction and 48 hours in advance of a tie-in. The contact person is Jeff Hardison (252-560-1492).

The Contractor shall provide access for the owner's representatives during construction and provide a set of as-built plans to North Lenoir Water Corporation after all work shown on the Utility Construction Plan is completed.

Page 15-9, Subarticle 1515-2 Materials, add the following sentences:

The proposed utility construction shall meet the applicable requirements (i.e. material specifications, standard details, testing, policies, etc.) of the NCDOT's "Standard Specifications for Roads and Structures" (dated July, 2006) and North Lenoir Water Corporation's "Minimum Contract Requirements for Privately Financed and Constructed Water Line Extensions to North Lenoir Water Corporation System."

Measurement and payment for work will be in accordance with NCDOT's "Standard Specifications for Roads and Structures" (dated July, 2006).

In addition to the water line materials specified under Section 1036, the water line can be High Density Polyethylene (HDPE) pipe conforming to AWWA C906 with an SDR of 9 and pressure rating of 200 # WP.
