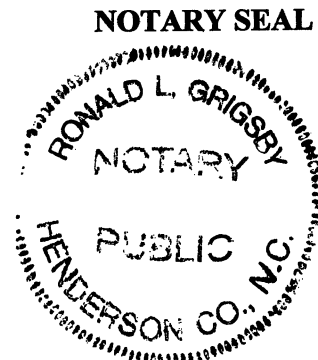

DEBARMENT CERTIFICATION
