## DEBARMENT CERTIFICATION



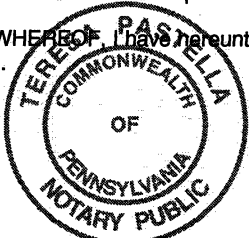
