

Project Special Provisions

Utility Construction
November 6, 2012

Revise the 2012 Standard Specifications as follows:

Page 15-1, Subarticle 1500-2 Cooperation with the Utility Owner, paragraph 2, add the following sentences:

The existing water lines belong to Cleveland County. The contact person for Cleveland County is Mr. Clyde Smith, Jr. at (704) 538-9033.

The existing sewer line belongs to the Town of Lattimore. The contact person for the Town of Lattimore is Mr. Alton Beal at (704) 434-2620.

The contractor shall provide access for the owner’s representatives to all phases of construction. Any work on these lines must be coordinated through the Engineer and the utility owner before beginning.

Page 15-7, Subarticle 1515-2 Materials, add the following sentence:

Sanitary sewer force main plug valve shall meet AWWA C517 for resilient-seated cast iron eccentric plug valves.

Measurement and payment:


Work will be measured and paid for per each valve. Such payment will be full compensation for all work and materials, valve box, actuator, etc., covered by this provision, including excavation, backfill, concrete and all other material incidental to performing the work.

Valve to be installed in a vertical or horizontal position, as directed by the Town of Lattimore.

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UTILITIES BY OTHERS:

General:

The following utility companies have facilities that will be in conflict with the construction of this project.

- A) AT&T / MCNC – Telephone
- B) Duke Energy – Distribution Power
- C) Duke Energy – Transmission Power
- D) Time Warner Cable – CATV
- E) City of Shelby – Gas

The conflicting facilities of these concerns will be installed, adjusted, removed or abandoned prior to the date of availability, unless otherwise noted and are therefore listed in these special provisions for the benefit of the Contractor. All utility work listed herein will be done by the utility owner. All utilities are shown on the plans from the best available information.

The Contractor's attention is directed to Article 105-8 of the 2012 Standard Specifications.

Utilities Requiring Adjustment:

- A) AT&T / MCNC – Telephone
 - 1) AT&T / MCNC will abandon, adjust, relocate or remove its facilities at the locations within the project limits as necessary as shown on the Utilities by Others Plans. Most facilities will go on joint use poles with Duke Energy and Time Warner Cable.
 - 2) Contact person for AT&T / MCNC is Mr. Steve Mode at 704-617-6525.
- B) Duke Energy – Distribution Power
 - 1) Duke Energy will abandon, adjust, relocate or remove its facilities at the locations within the project limits as necessary as shown on the Utilities by Others Plans.
 - 2) Contact person for Duke Energy is Mr. Fred Liles at 828-323-2773.

- C) Duke Energy – Transmission Power
- 1) Duke Energy will adjust its transmission towers at the locations within the project limits as necessary as shown on the Utilities by Others Plans.
 - 2) Contact person for Duke Energy is Mr. Tray Riggins at 704-382-7729.
- D) Time Warner Cable – CATV
- 1) Time Warner Cable will abandon, adjust, relocate or remove its facilities at the locations within the project limits as necessary as shown on the Utilities by Others Plans. Facilities will go on joint use poles with Duke Energy distribution and AT&T telephone.

- E) City of Shelby – Gas
- 1) The City of Shelby will abandon, adjust, relocate or remove its facilities at the locations within the project limits as necessary as shown on the Utilities by Others Plans.
