

GENERAL NOTES

THE FOLLOWING GENERAL NOTES APPLY AT ALL TIMES FOR THE DURATION OF THE CONSTRUCTION PROJECT, EXCEPT WHEN OTHERWISE NOTED IN THE PLAN, OR DIRECTED BY THE ENGINEER.

A) INSTALL PAVEMENT MARKINGS AND PAVEMENT MARKERS ON THE FINAL SURFACE AS FOLLOWS:

ROAD NAME MARKING MARKER

ALL THERMOPLASTIC SNOWPLOWABLE

CONCRETE BRIDGE DECK COLD APPLIED PLASTIC RAISED

COLD APPLIED PLASTIC (TYPE II OR III)

- B) TIE PROPOSED PAVEMENT MARKING LINES TO EXISTING PAVEMENT MARKING LINES.
- C) REMOVE/REPLACE ANY CONFLICTING/DAMAGED PAVEMENT MARKINGS AND MARKERS.
- D) PASSING ZONES WILL BE DETERMINED IN THE FIELD AND MUST BE APPROVED BY THE ENGINEER.
- E) STOP BAR LOCATION AT NON-SIGNALIZED INTERSECTIONS MAY BE ADJUSTED AS DIRECTED BY THE ENGINEER.
- F) REMOVE ALL RESIDUE AND SURFACE LAITANCE BY ACCEPTABLE METHODS ON CONCRETE BRIDGE DECKS PRIOR TO PLACING COLD APPLIED PLASTIC PAVEMENT MARKING MATERIAL.
- G) UNLESS OTHERWISE SPECIFIED, HEATED-IN-PLACE THERMOPLASTIC MAY BE USED IN LIEU OF EXTRUDED THERMOPLASTIC FOR STOP BARS, SYMBOLS, CHARACTERS AND DIAGONALS. IF HEATED-IN-PLACE IS USED, IT SHALL BE PAID FOR USING THE EXTRUDED THERMOPLASTIC PAY ITEM.
- H) UNLESS OTHERWISE SPECIFIED, HEATED-IN-PLACE THERMOPLASTIC MAY BE USED IN LIEU OF COLD APPLIED PLASTIC FOR STOP BARS, SYMBOLS, CHARACTERS AND DIAGONALS ON ASPHALT OR CONCRETE ROADWAYS. IF HEATED-IN-PLACE IS USED, IT SHALL BE PAID FOR USING THE COLD APPLIED PAY ITEM.
- I) ALL BIKE LANE SYMBOLS SHALL BE HEATED-IN-PLACE THERMOPLASTIC. SYMBOLS SHALL BE PAID FOR USING THE HEAT-IN-PLACE PAY ITEM.
- J) TYPE III COLD APPLIED PLASTIC MAY BE USED IN LIEU OF TYPE II COLD APPLIED PLASTIC. IF TYPE III COLD APPLIED PLASTIC IS USED, IT SHALL BE PAID FOR USING THE TYPE II COLD APPLIED PLASTIC PAY ITEM.
- K) SEE ROADWAY PLANS FOR ALTERNATE CURB RAMP DESIGNS WHEN INDICATED ON PAVEMENT MARKING DETAIL SHEETS.
