(THIS NOTE ONLY APPLIES TO E. LEXINGTON AVENUE. N. COLLEGE DRIVE. N. CENTENNIAL STREET AND MONTLIEU AVENUE).
- 11. FOR HIGH POINT UNIVERSITY BASKETBALL GAMES, OCCURRING AT MILLS CENTER BETWEEN TWO (2) HOURS BEFORE THE START AND TWO (2) HOURS AFTER THE END OF THE HIGH POINT UNIVERSITY BASKETBALL GAMES. (THIS NOTE ONLY APPLIES TO E. LEXINGTON AVENUE, N. COLLEGE DRIVE, N. CENTENNIAL STREET AND MONTLIEU AVENUE).
- 12. FOR WEEKENDS DURING THE HOLIDAY SHOPPING PERIOD AT OAK HOLLOW MALL BETWEEN THE WEEKEND OF THANKSGIVING AND THE WEEKEND OF CHRISTMAS, BETWEEN THE HOURS OF 9:00 AM AND 9:00 PM ON BOTH SATURDAY AND SUNDAY. (THIS NOTE ONLY APPLIES TO E. HARTLEY DRIVE AND EASTCHESTER DRIVE).

- C) DO NOT CLOSE OR NARROW TRAVEL LANES OR CLOSE SIDEWALKS OR PEDESTRIAN CROSSINGS WITHIN THE HIGH POINT UNIVERSITY (HPU) MAIN CAMPUS AREA. SUBMIT TO THE CITY FOR REVIEW AND APPROVAL TWO WEEKS IN ADVANCE A SCHEDULE FOR PROPOSED WORK THAT WILL REQUIRE NARROWING OR CLOSING A LANE, ROAD, SIDEWALK OR PEDESTRIAN CROSSING. THE HPU MAIN CAMPUS AREA IS DEFINED AS THE AREA BOUNDED BY E. LEXINGTON AVENUE, N. COLLEGE DRIVE, N. CENTENNIAL STREET AND MONTLIEU AVENUE.
- D) DO NOT CLOSE OR NARROW TRAVEL LANES OR CLOSE SIDEWALKS OR PEDESTRIAN CROSSINGS WITHIN 1/2 MILE OF A SCHOOL DURING ARRIVAL AND DISMISSAL HOURS ON A SCHOOL DAY. COORDINATE WITH THE AFFECTED SCHOOL CONCERNING OPERATIONAL HOURS AND SCHOOL DAYS. AS A MINIMUM, DO NOT CLOSE OR NARROW A LANE OR CLOSE A SIDEWALK OR PEDESTRIAN CROSSING DURING HOURS POSTED ON SCHOOL SPEED ZONE SIGNS (WHEN PRESENT).



LANE AND SHOULDER CLOSURE REQUIREMENTS

- F) ON STREETS WHERE POSTED SPEED LIMIT IS 40 MPH OR LESS AND WORK IS ON THE SHOULDER, CLOSE THE SHOULDER USING RSD 1101.04 OR USE A SHOULDER CLOSURE WITH MINOR ENCROACHMENT INTO THE ADJACENT TRAFFIC LANE AS SHOWN IN M.U.T.C.D. FIGURE 6H-6, "SHOULDER WORK WITH MINOR ENCROACHMENT (TA-6)." WHEN USING TA-6, COMPLY WITH THE APPLICATION NOTES ON MUTCD PAGE 6H-16, AND MAINTAIN A MINIMUM OF 10-FT TRAVEL LANE. CLOSE AFFECTED SIDEWALKS AND PEDESTRIAN PATHS. WHERE A 10FT. OR GREATER TRAVEL LANE CANNOT BE MAINTAINED OR AS DIRECTED BY THE ENGINEER. CLOSE THE ADJACENT TRAFFIC LANE USING RSD 1101.02. SHEETS 1 THRU 4 OF 15.
- G) REMOVE LANE CLOSURE DEVICES FROM THE LANE WHEN WORK IS NOT BEING PERFORMED BEHIND THE LANE CLOSURE OR WHEN A LANE CLOSURE IS NO LONGER NEEDED, OR AS DIRECTED BY THE ENGINEER.
- H) WHEN PERSONNEL AND/OR EQUIPMENT ARE WORKING GREATER THAN 5 FT BUT LESS THAN 15 FT FROM AN OPEN TRAVEL LANE ON A ROADWAY WITH A POSTED SPEED LIMIT OF 45 MPH OR GREATER. CLOSE THE ADJACENT SHOULDER USING ROADWAY STANDARD DRAWING NO. 1101.04 UNLESS THE WORK AREA IS PROTECTED BY BARRIER OR GUARDRAIL OR A LANE CLOSURE IS INSTALLED.
- I) WHEN PERSONNEL AND/OR EQUIPMENT ARE WORKING WITHIN 5 FT OF AN OPEN TRAVEL LANE ON A ROADWAY WITH A POSTED SPEED LIMIT OF 45 MPH OR GREATER. CLOSE THE NEAREST OPEN TRAVEL LANE USING ROADWAY STANDARD DRAWING NO. 1101.02 UNLESS THE WORK AREA IS PROTECTED BY BARRIER OR GUARDRAIL.
- J) WHEN PERSONNEL AND/OR EQUIPMENT ARE WORKING WITHIN A LANE OF TRAVEL OF AN UNDIVIDED OR DIVIDED FACILITY, CLOSE THE LANE ACCORDING TO THE ROADWAY STANDARD DRAWINGS OR AS DIRECTED BY THE ENGINEER. CONDUCT THE WORK SO THAT ALL PERSONNEL AND/OR EQUIPMENT REMAIN WITHIN THE CLOSED TRAVEL LANE.
- K) DO NOT INSTALL MORE THAN ONE LANE CLOSURE IN ANY ONE DIRECTION ON ANY ROADWAY.
