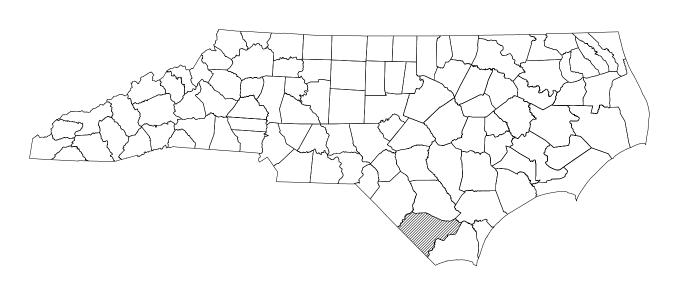
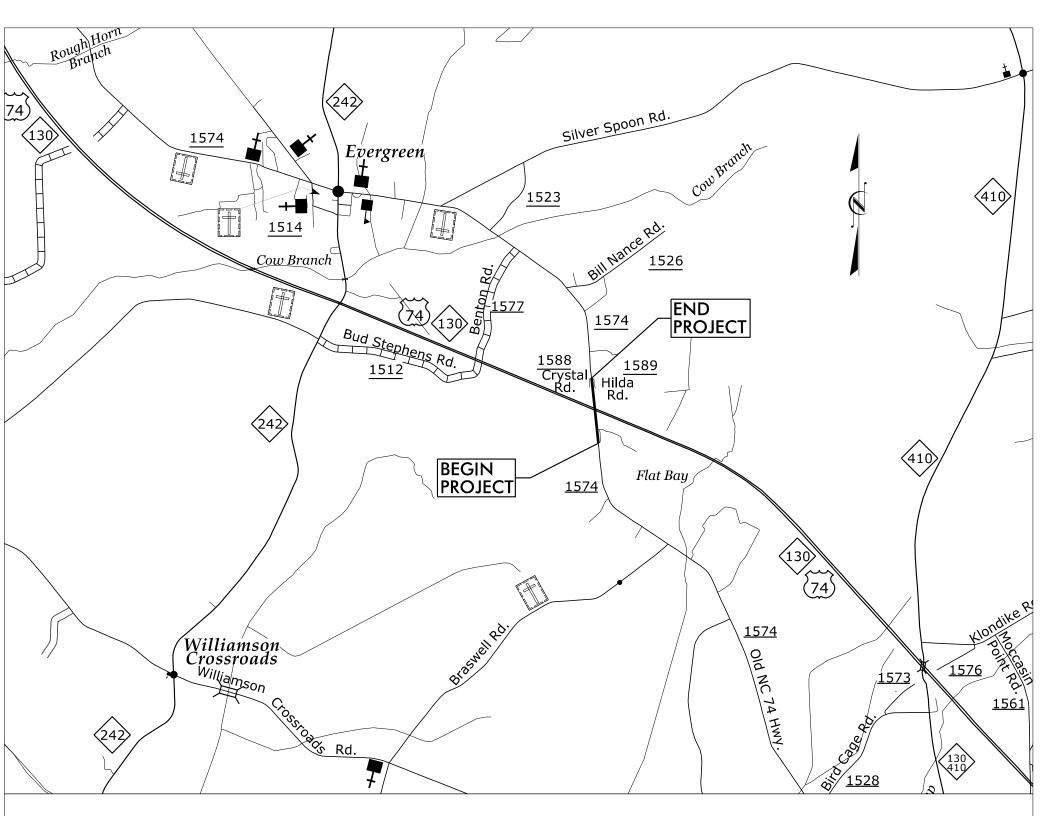

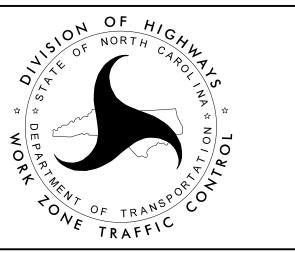
VICINITY MAP

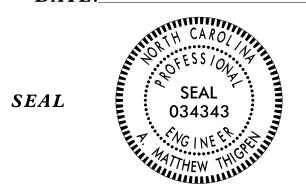

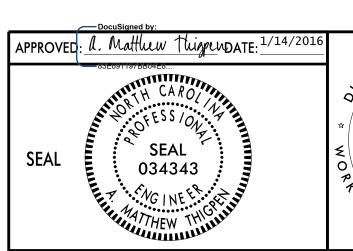

- D) REMOVE LANE CLOSURE DEVICES FROM THE LANE WHEN WORK IS NOT BEING PERFORMED BEHIND THE LANE CLOSURE OR WHEN A LANE CLOSURE IS NO LONGER NEEDED OR AS DIRECTED BY THE ENGINEER.
- E) WHEN PERSONNEL AND/OR EQUIPMENT ARE WORKING WITHIN 15 FT OF AN OPEN TRAVEL LANE, CLOSE THE NEAREST OPEN SHOULDER USING ROADWAY STANDARD DRAWING NO. 1101.04 UNLESS THE WORK AREA IS PROTECTED BY BARRIER OR GUARDRAIL OR A LANE CLOSURE IS INSTALLED.

L) BACKFILL AT A 6:1 SLOPE UP TO THE EDGE AND ELEVATION OF EXISTING PAVEMENT IN AREAS ADJACENT TO AN OPENED TRAVEL LANE THAT HAS AN EDGE OF PAVEMENT DROP-OFF AS FOLLOWS:

BACKFILL DROP-OFFS THAT EXCEED 2 INCHES ON ROADWAYS WITH POSTED SPEED LIMITS OF 45 MPH OR GREATER.

USING RSD 1101.02, SHEET 4 OF 15, AS NECESSARY, CONSTRUCT SHOULDERS AND MILL EXISTING PAVEMENT ON -Y- FROM STA. 15+90 +/- TO 33+10 +/- AND PLACE TEMPORARY PAVEMENT MARKINGS IN THE EXISTING PATTERN (SEE SHEETS TMP-5 AND TMP-7 AND LOCAL NOTE LN-2).

STEP 6

AWAY FROM TRAFFIC AND USING RSD 1101.02, SHEET 4 OF 15, AS NECESSARY, PERFORM THE FOLLOWING:

- PLACE FINAL LAYER OF SURFACE COURSE ON ALL LANES.
- PLACE TEMPORARY MARKINGS ON ALL LANES IN THE FINAL TRAFFIC PATTERN (SEE PAVEMENT MARKING PLANS).
- REMOVE ALL ROAD CLOSURE AND DETOUR SIGNING, REMOVE ALL ROAD CLOSURE BARRICADES AND OPEN ALL LANES TO PROPOSED TRAFFIC PATTERN.

STEP 7

USING RSD 1101.02, SHEETS 1 AND 4 OF 15, AND LAW ENFORCEMENT WHEN NECESSARY, PLACE FINAL PAVEMENT MARKINGS AND MARKERS (SEE PAVEMENT MARKING PLANS).

STEP 8

REMOVE ALL REMAINING TRAFFIC CONTROL DEVICES.

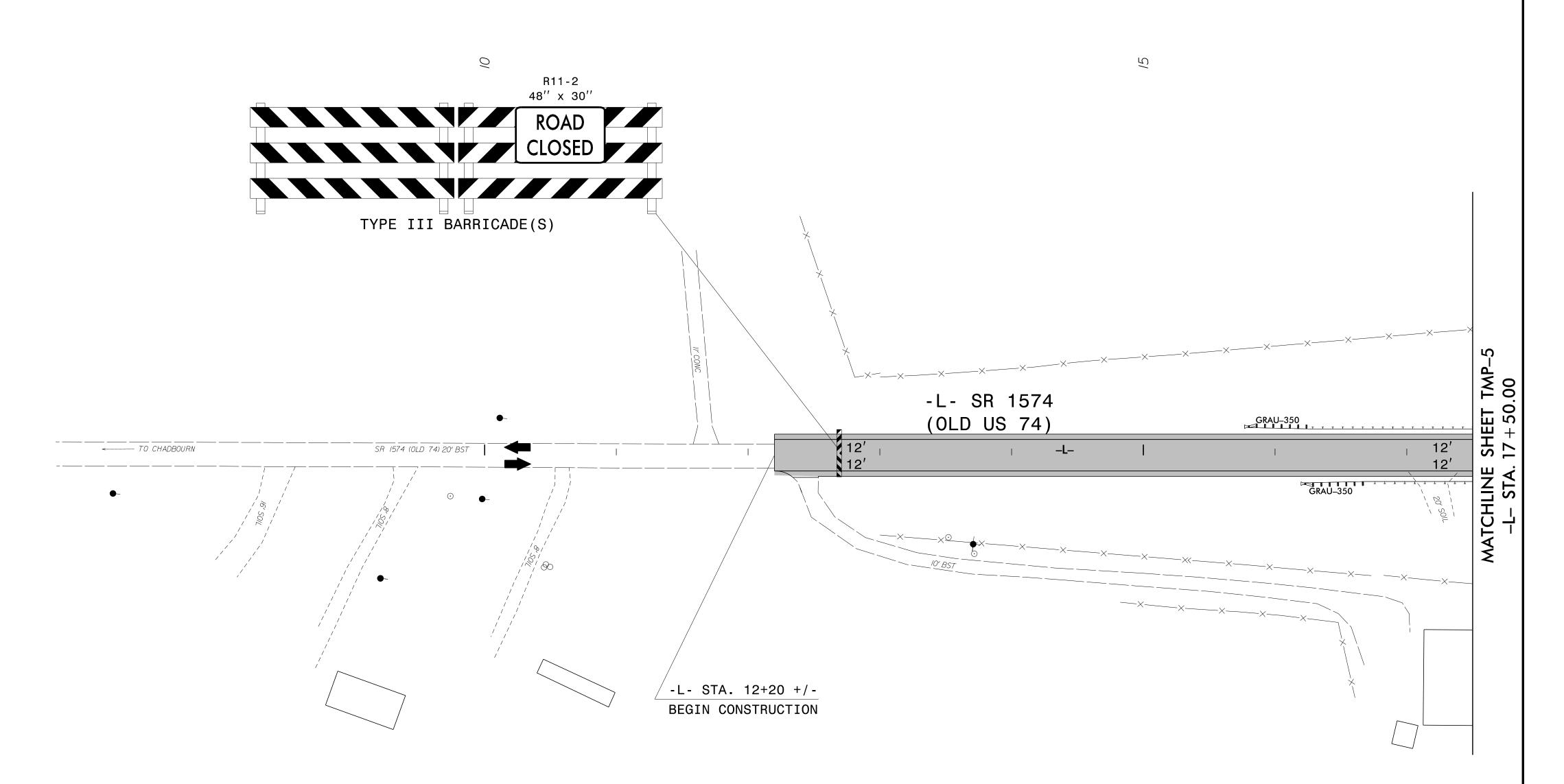

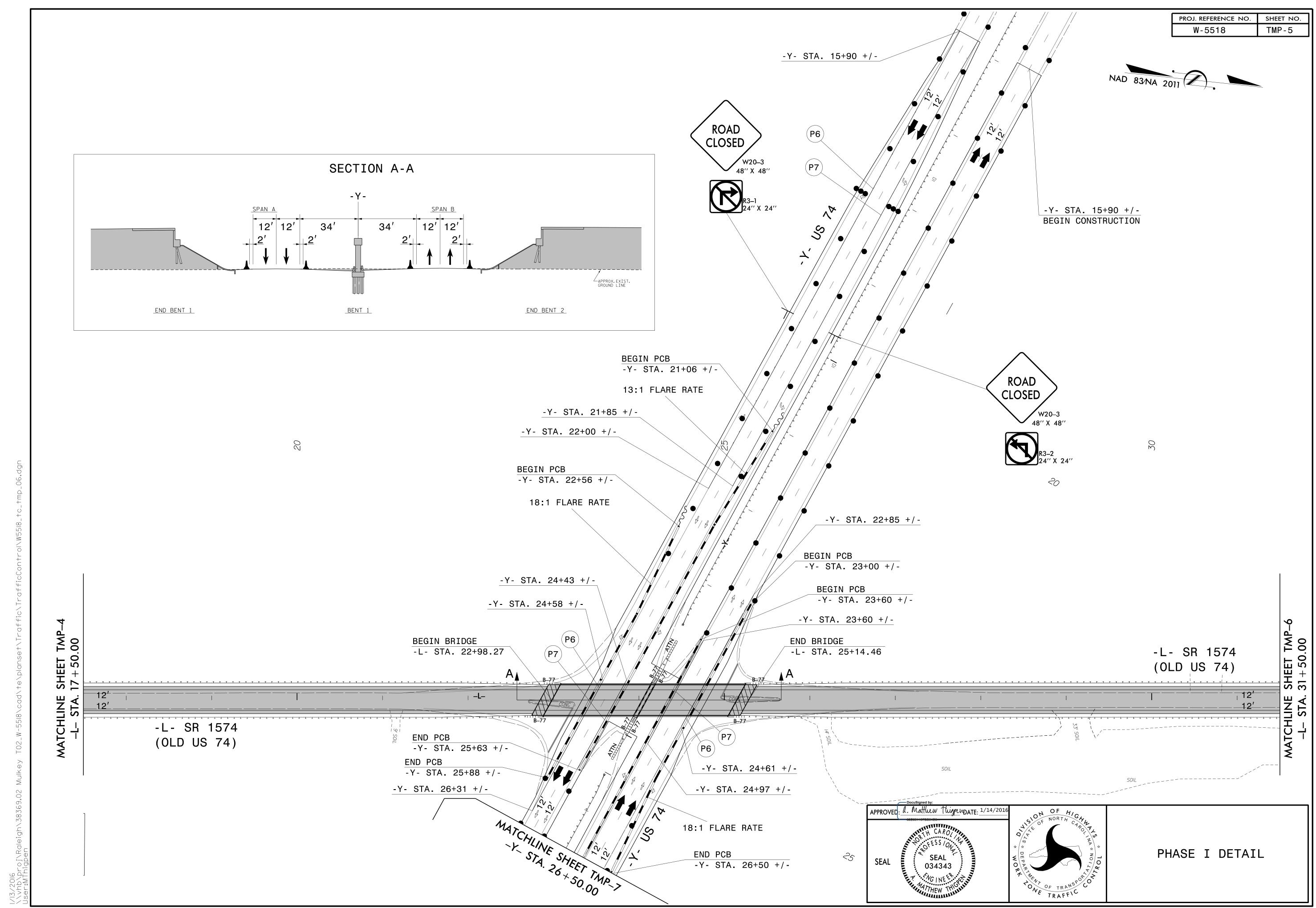






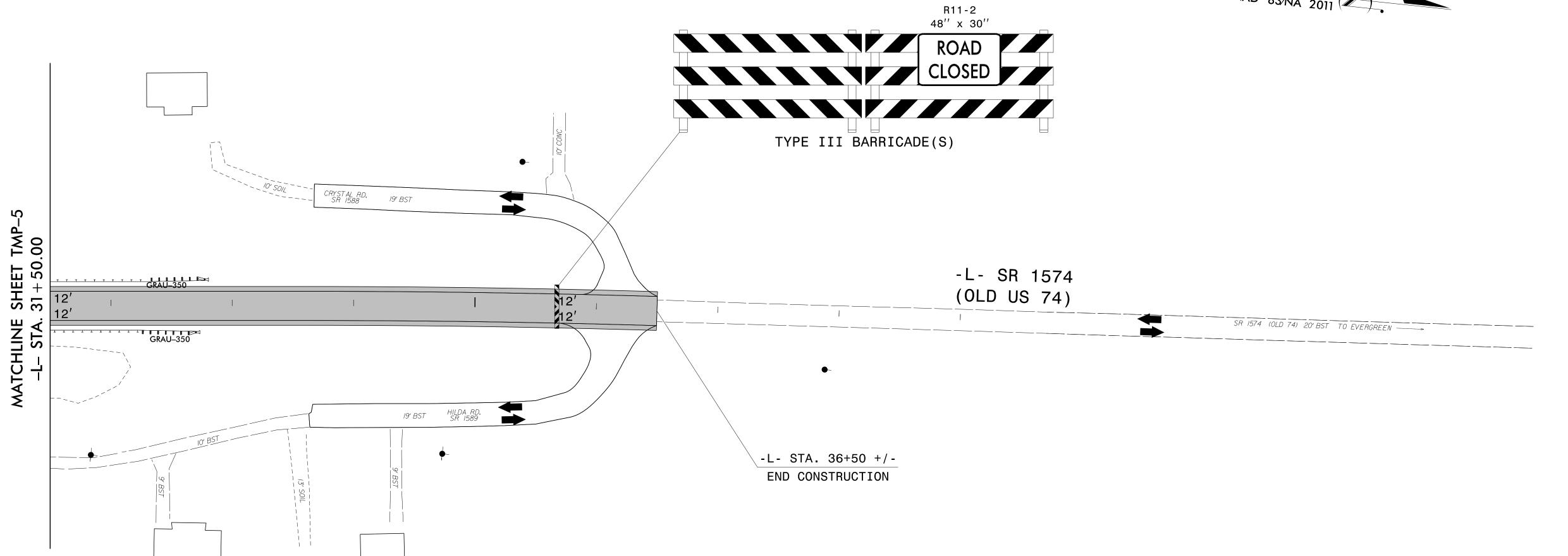


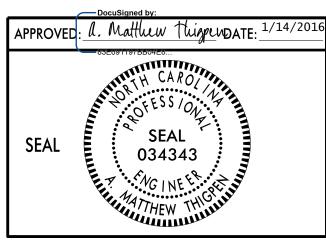
PHASE I DETAIL
