PILES AT END BENT 1 & 2 ARE DESIGNED FOR A FACTORED RESISTANCE OF 75 TONS PER PILE.

DRIVE PILES AT END BENT 1 & 2 TO A REQUIRED DRIVING RESISTANCE OF 125 TONS PER PILE.

THE CONTRACTOR SHALL PROVIDE INDEPENDENT ASSURANCE SAMPLES OF REINFORCING STEEL AS FOLLOWS: FOR PROJECTS REQUIRING UP TO 400 TONS OF REINFORCING STEEL, ONE 30 INCH SAMPLE OF EACH SIZE BAR USED, AND FOR PROJECTS REQUIRING OVER 400 TONS OF REINFORCING STEEL, TWO 30 INCH SAMPLES OF EACH SIZE BAR USED. THE BARS FROM WHICH THE SAMPLES ARE TAKEN MUST THEN BE SPLICED WITH REPLACEMENT BARS OF THE SIZE AND LENGTH OF THE SAMPLE, PLUS A MINIMUM LAP SPLICE OF THIRTY BAR DIAMETERS. PAYMENT FOR THE SAMPLES OF REINFORCING STEEL SHALL BE CONSIDERED INCIDENTAL TO VARIOUS PAY ITEMS.

AFTER SERVING AS A TEMPORARY STRUCTURE, THE EXISTING 3 SPAN STRUCTURE (1 @ 17'-8", 1 @ 17'-2", 1 @ 17'-8") WITH A CLEAR ROADWAY WIDTH OF 24'-O" AND A 5" REINFORCED CONCRETE FLOOR IMBER JOISTS, WITH END BENTS AND BENTS CONSISTING OF ER CAPS ON TIMBER PILES AND LOCATED UPSTREAM FROM THE OSED STRUCTURE SHALL BE REMOVED. THE EXISTING BRIDGE IS ENTLY POSTED FOR LOAD LIMIT. SHOULD THE STRUCTURAL GRITY OF THE BRIDGE DETERIORATE DURING CONSTRUCTION OF PROPOSED BRIDGE, THE LOAD LIMIT MAY BE REDUCED AS FOUND SSARY DURING THE LIFE OF THE PROJECT.

AL OF THE EXISTING BRIDGE SHALL BE PERFORMED IN A ER THAT PREVENTS DEBRIS FROM FALLING INTO THE WATER. CONTRACTOR SHALL SUBMIT DEMOLITION PLANS FOR REVIEW AND /E THE BRIDGE IN ACCORDANCE WITH ARTICLE 402-2 OF THE DARD SPECIFICATIONS.

STRUCTURE HAS BEEN DESIGNED IN ACCORDANCE WITH "HEC ALUATING SCOUR AT BRIDGES.

FOR EROSION CONTROL MEASURES, SEE EROSION CONTROL PLANS.

ASPHALT WEARING SURFACE IS INCLUDED IN ROADWAY QUANTITY ON ROADWAY PLANS.

FOR ASBESTOS ASSESSMENT FOR BRIDGE DEMOLITION AND RENOVATION ACTIVITIES, SEE SPECIAL PROVISIONS.

AT THE CONTRACTOR'S OPTION, PRESTRESSED CONCRETE END BENT CAPS MAY BE SUBSTITUTED IN PLACE OF THE CAST-IN-PLACE CAPS. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL COORDINATE WITH THE RESIDENT ENGINEER TO RECEIVE REVISED PLANS AND DETAILS FROM THE STRUCTURES MANAGEMENT UNIT. THE REDESIGN AND ANY ADDITIONAL MATERIALS NEEDED WILL BE AT NO ADDITIONAL COST TO THE CONTRACTOR.
