



NOTES

- 2. Do not program signal for late night flashing operation unless otherwise directed by the Engineer.
- 3. Set all detector units to presence mode.
- 4. Install new signal heads with enough signal cable to allow for the repositioning of signal heads as shown in the temporary and final signal designs
- 5. Relocate street name signs to new spanwires.
- 6. Maximum times shown in timing chart are for free-run operation only. Coordinated signal system timing values supersede these values.

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
