The Contractor shall not close or narrow a lane of traffic on NC 904 (Causeway Drive) during the following time restrictions:

DAY AND TIME RESTRICTIONS

Week before Memorial Day to Week after Labor Day (Summer)
Monday thru Thursday, 5:00 A.M. to 9:00 P.M.

From Friday at 5:00 A.M. to Sunday at 9:00 P.M.

Week after Labor Day to Week Before Memorial Day (Off-Season)
Monday thru Thursday, 6:00 A.M. to 9:00 A.M. & 4:00 P.M. to 7:00 P.M.

From Friday at 6:00 A.M. to Sunday at 7:00 P.M.

In addition, the Contractor shall not close or narrow a lane of traffic on NC 904 (Causeway Drive), detain and/or alter the traffic flow on or during holidays, holiday weekends, special events, or any other time when traffic is unusually heavy, including the following schedules:
