CHANGES MAY BE REQUIRED WHEN PHYSICAL DIMENSIONS IN THE DETAIL DRAWINGS, STANDARD DETAILS, AND ROADWAY DETAILS ARE NOT ATTAINABLE TO MEET FIELD CONDITIONS OR RESULT IN DUPLICATE OR UNDESIRED OVERLAPPING OF DEVICES. MODIFICATION MAY INCLUDE: MOVING, SUPPLEMENTING, COVERING, OR REMOVAL OF DEVICES AS DIRECTED BY THE ENGINEER.

THE FOLLOWING GENERAL NOTES APPLY AT ALL TIMES FOR THE DURATION OF THE CONSTRUCTION PROJECT EXCEPT WHEN OTHERWISE NOTED IN THE PLAN OR DIRECTED BY THE ENGINEER.

TRAFFIC PATTERN ALTERATIONS

A) NOTIFY THE ENGINEER THIRTY (30) CALENDAR DAYS PRIOR TO ANY TRAFFIC PATTERN ALTERATION.

SIGNING

B) PROVIDE SIGNING AND DEVICES REQUIRED TO CLOSE THE ROAD ACCORDING TO THE ROADWAY STANDARD DRAWINGS AND TRAFFIC CONTROL PLANS.

PROVIDE SIGNING REQUIRED FOR THE OFF-SITE DETOUR ROUTE AS SHOWN IN THE TRAFFIC CONTROL PLANS.

C) COVER OR REMOVE ALL SIGNS AND DEVICES REQUIRED TO CLOSE THE ROAD WHEN ROAD CLOSURE IS NOT IN OPERATION.

COVER OR REMOVE ALL SIGNS REQUIRED FOR THE OFF-SITE DETOUR WHEN THE DETOUR IS NOT IN OPERATION.

D) ENSURE ALL NECESSARY SIGNING IS IN PLACE PRIOR TO ALTERING ANY TRAFFIC PATTERN.



E) PLACE TYPE III BARRICADES, WITH "ROAD CLOSED" SIGN R11-2 ATTACHED, OF SUFFICIENT LENGTH TO CLOSE ENTIRE ROADWAY.

PHASING

- STEP 1. USING ROADWAY STANDARD DRAWINGS 1101.03, SHEETS 1 & 2, AND TMP-2 INSTALL OFFSITE DETOUR SIGNS AND TRAFFIC CONTROL DEVICES AND CLOSE SHUMATE MOUNTAIN ROAD (SR 1745) AND MIDDLE FORK ROAD (SR 1746) TO THROUGH TRAFFIC.
- STEP 2. COMPLETE THE FOLLOWING WITHIN THE ROAD CLOSURE:
 - A) REMOVE THE EXISTING BRIDGE.
 - B) CONSTRUCT THE PROPOSED BRIDGE AND ROADWAY APPROACHES INCLUDING THE FINAL LAYER OF SURFACE COURSE AND FINAL PAVEMENT MARKINGS.
- STEP 3. REMOVE ALL TRAFFIC CONTROL DEVICES AND DETOUR SIGNS AND OPEN SHUMATE MOUNTAIN ROAD (SR 1745) AND MIDDLE FORK ROAD (SR 1746) TO THROUGH TRAFFIC.
