<p>GENERAL NOTES:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1- USE THE COLOR WHITE FOR ALL PAVEMENT MARKING SYMBOLS. 2- DO NOT LOCATE PAVEMENT MARKING SYMBOLS AS TO ENCOACH INTO INTERSECTION AREAS. 3- DO NOT PLACE SYMBOLS ACROSS TRANSVERSE EXPANSION JOINTS ON PORTLAND CEMENT CONCRETE PAVEMENTS, UNLESS APPROVED BY THE ENGINEER. 4- CONFORM ALL SYMBOLS TO THE FHWA "STANDARD HIGHWAY SIGNS" MANUAL WHICH INCLUDES PAVEMENT MARKINGS AND STANDARD ALPHABETS (REFER TO SHEETS 6 THRU 9). DIMENSIONS CAN VARY AMONG MANUFACTURERS, THEREFORE SLIGHT VARIANCES ARE ACCEPTABLE. HOWEVER, ALL SYMBOLS ARE REQUIRED TO BE APPROVED BY THE DEPARTMENT.
