Dear Mr. Dilday:

This letter is in response to the Pre-Construction Notification (PCN) you submitted to the Wilmington District, WRDA / Transportation Branch,on December 19, 2024, for a Department of the Army Nationwide permit (NWP) verification. This project has been assigned the file number SAW-2021-01091 and is known as NCDOT HB-0001 Alligator River Bridge. This file number should be referenced in all correspondence concerning this project.

A review of the information provided indicates that the proposed work would include the installation of 19 mooring piles and 3 heavy weather moorings on the east side of the Alligator River. The project area for this determination is illustrated on the enclosed site plans/maps. The project/review area is located in the Alligator River; approximately 0.7 miles north of the Alligator River Bridge near the eastern shore, at Latitude 35.901120 and Longitude -75.976550; east of the town of Columbia, Tyrrell County, North Carolina.

We have determined that the proposed work is authorized by Nationwide Permit #33 pursuant to authorities under Section 10 of the Rivers and Harbors Act of 1899 (33 U.S.C. § 403). The proposed work must be accomplished in strict accordance with the general permit conditions, any regional conditions, the special conditions listed in this letter, the application materials, and the enclosed plans. If the extent of the project area and/or nature of the authorized impacts to waters are modified, a revised PCN must be submitted to this office for written approval before work is initiated. Any violation of permit conditions or deviation from your submitted plans may subject the permittee to enforcement action.

This verification is valid until March 14, 2026, unless prior to this date the subject NWP(s) is suspended, revoked, or is modified such that the activity no longer complies with the terms and conditions of this NWP. If you commence or are under contract to commence this activity before the date that the relevant NWP is modified or revoked,

you will have 12 months from the date of the modification or revocation of the NWP to complete the activity under the present terms and conditions of this NWP.

Project Specific Special Conditions:

1. The NCDOT shall implement the "Guidelines for Avoiding Impacts to the West Indian Manatee: Precautionary Measures for Construction Activities in North Carolina Waters" as identified by the USFW Service.

This NWP verification does not preclude the necessity to obtain any other Federal, State, or local permits, licenses, and/or certifications, which may be required.

- Unless specifically altered herein, this Minor Modification authorizes the following: (1) installation of 19 additional temporary 30-inch steel pipe mooring piles for securing barges in place for bridge construction. The piles shall be spaced approximately 60 feet apart for a total distance of approximately 1,080 linear feet; (2) and use of 3 temporary heavy weather mooring anchorages with 30,000 pound anchors, attached to a mooring chain, line and buoy, for securing barges in the event of severe weather. The radius of each heavy weather mooring will be a maximum of 500 feet, all as depicted on the attached workplan drawings. No other structures, whether floating or stationary, shall become a part of the authorized facilities without additional authorization from DCM. No non-water dependent uses of structures shall be conducted on, in or over Public Trust waters without permit modification. [07H .0208(a)(1); 07J .0202; 07J .0202(c)].
- 2) No additional temporary and/or permanent impacts to wetlands are authorized by this permit modification without prior approval from DCM. [07J .0202(c)].



- In accordance with commitments made by the permittee, and in order to protect fisheries resources, no in-water work shall be conducted in the Alligator River from July 15 to September 30 of any year, and in addition, no in-water work shall be conducted in the deepwater channel of the Alligator River (between new bridge bents 44-57) from February 15 to June 30, without prior approval of the N.C. Division of Coastal Management (DCM), in consultation with the appropriate resource agencies. [07H .0208(a)(2)].
- 4) The installation and removal of the piles shall be accomplished by pile driving and/or vibratory hammer. Should the permittee and/or its contractor propose to utilize another type of installation or removal, such as jetting or drilled shaft construction, additional authorization from DCM shall be required. [07J .0202(c); 07J .0405(a)].
- The authorized temporary mooring piles and heavy weather mooring anchorages shall be removed in their entirety within 90 days after they are no longer needed, or within 30 days of written notification from DCM, whichever comes first. However, if this timeframe occurs while the in-water work moratorium of this permit modification is in effect, then the temporary mooring piles and heavy weather mooring anchorages shall be removed in their entirety within 90 days of the moratorium end date. If a temporary mooring pile is unable to be removed in its entirety, it may be cut off flush with the bed of the water body, and DCM shall be notified of each occurrence within one working day. [07H .0208(a)(2); 07H .0208(b)(10)(F)].
- Barges shall be utilized only in areas of sufficient depth such that the barges avoid contact with the bottom and do not rest on the bottom during periods of low water. [07J .0201].
- 7) No sewage, whether treated or untreated, shall be discharged at any time from any vessels using the authorized facilities. [07H .0208(a)(2)(B)].
- 8) The moorings, anchorages and attached vessels shall not interfere with the access of any riparian owner nor shall it block riparian access by blocking channels, deep water, etc. which allows riparian access. [07H .0208(b)(10)(B)(i)].
- 9) The permittee and/or its contractor shall contact the DCM Transportation Project Field Representative by phone at (252) 948-3855 or by email at <u>Lee.cannady@deq.nc.gov</u> to request a preconstruction conference prior to project initiation. [G.S 113A-120(b); 07J .0209(a)].
- 10) The permittee shall install and maintain at their expense any signal lights or signals prescribed by the U.S. Coast Guard and the N.C. Wildlife Resources Commission, through regulation or otherwise, on the authorized facilities in order to make them more visible during hours of darkness or inclement weather. For further information, the permittee should contact the U.S. Coast Guard Marine Safety Office. [G.S. 113-229(a); 07H .0208(a)(2)(G); 07J .0209(a)].
- All conditions and stipulations of the active permit remain in force under this Minor Modification unless specifically altered herein. [07J .0209(a)].

12) If it is determined that additional permanent and/or temporary impacts are necessary that are not shown on the attached workplan drawings or described in the authorized permit application, a permit modification and/or additional authorization from DCM may be required. In addition, any changes in the approved plan may also require a permit modification and/or additional authorization from DCM. The permittee shall contact a representative of DCM prior to commencement of any such activity for this determination and any permit modification. [07J .0201].


- NOTE: A CAMA/Dredge and Fill Permit is a determination that the proposed development meets the CAMA/Dredge and Fill laws and CRC's rules for coastal development. It is not a determination of private property ownership or an authorization to trespass onto property owned by someone other than the Permittee.
- NOTE: This permit action may be appealed by the permittee or other qualified persons within twenty (20) days of the issuing date. Any development authorized under this permit that occurs prior to the expiration of the twenty (20) day appeal period or completion of an appeal process, shall be done at the permittee's risk.
- NOTE: It is strongly recommended that the permittee exercise all available precautions in the day-to-day operation to prevent waste from entering the adjacent waters. Such discharge, either directly or indirectly, to adjacent waters could contravene state water quality standards, thereby violating state law.
- NOTE: This Minor Modification does not eliminate the need to obtain any additional permits, approvals or authorizations that may be required. This includes approval, if required, from the N.C. Division of Water Resources, the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers and/or the U.S. Coast Guard.
- NOTE: This Minor Modification shall be attached to the original of Permit No. 136-23, which was issued on 11/30/23, as well as the Minor Modification which was issued on 1/19/24, and copies of all documents shall be readily available on site when a Division representative inspects the project for compliance.
- **NOTE:** A minor modification application processing fee of \$100 was received by DCM for this project.









Location description: The project area is located on either side of the Alligator River along the alignment of US 64 approximately 13.5 miles east of the town of Columbia in Tyrrell County, North Carolina.

Description of projects area and activity: <a href="NCDOT proposes to drive 20 test piles at 15 different locations within the alignment of the proposed Alligator River Bridge location. These piles will be 36" or 48" in diameter and will be cut off below the mudline when the project is completed. Additionally, 19 piles 30" in diameter will be installed along a 1,080 foot alignment at 60 feet apart for the mooring of equipment for this project. These piles will be removed at the completion of the project.


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
- In accordance with commitments made by the permittee, and in order to protect fisheries resources, no in-water work shall be conducted in the Alligator River from July 15 to September 30 of any year, and in addition, no in-water work shall be conducted in the deepwater channel of the Alligator River (between new bridge bents 44-57) from February 15 to June 30, without prior approval of the N.C. Division of Coastal Management (DCM), in consultation with the appropriate resource agencies [07H .0208(a)(2)].
- 4) In accordance with commitments made in the permit modification request, test piles at Bent 47 shall be driven first due to the upcoming in-water work moratorium [07H .0208(a)(2)].
- **NOTE:** The permittee is strongly encouraged to contact the N.C. Division of Marine Fisheries Habitat Section to discuss the feasibility of collecting quantitative and qualitative data on the turbidity and noise that is generated during installation of the twenty exploratory test piles. This may result in a modification of the permit requirement to use turbidity curtains.
- The installation and removal of the test piles and mooring piles shall be accomplished by pile driving, vibratory hammer, and/or drilled pier. Should the permittee and/or its contractor propose to utilize another type of installation or removal, such as jetting or drilled shaft construction, additional authorization from DCM shall be required [07J .0202(c); 07J .0405(a)].
- 6) The test piles may be left in place and shall be cut off below the mudline [07H .0208(a)(3)].
- The authorized temporary mooring piles shall be removed in their entirety within 90 days after they are no longer needed, or within 30 days of written notification from DCM, whichever comes first, and disposed of at an approved high ground location. However, if this timeframe occurs while the in-water work moratorium of this permit modification is in effect, then the temporary mooring piles shall be removed in their entirety within 90 days of the moratorium end date. If a temporary mooring pile breaks during removal and cannot be removed in its entirety, it may be cut off flush with the bed of the water body, and DCM shall be notified of each occurrence within one working day [07H .0208(a)(2); 07H .0208(b)(10)(F)].
- 8) No sewage, whether treated or untreated, shall be discharged at any time from any vessels using the authorized facilities [07H .0208(a)(2)(B)].
- This minor modification authorizes only the structures that are expressly and specifically set forth in the permit application, and/or depicted on the authorized workplan drawings. No other structures, whether floating or stationary, shall become a part of the facilities authorized by this Minor Modification without additional authorization from DCM. No non-water dependent uses of structures shall be conducted on, in or over Public Trust waters without permit modification [07J .0202(c); 07H .0208(a)(1)].






- Throughout project construction and demolition, the permittee shall make every attempt to allow the same navigation that is currently possible in the Alligator River and adjacent public trust areas. If this is not possible, then adequate notice shall be provided to the public, including the managers of the Alligator River Marina and the Waterfront Access Marine Industry Fund (WAMI) site, that navigation will be limited during construction and/or demolition. The notice shall include an estimate of the amount of time that the limited navigation will occur [07H .0208(a)(2)(G)].
- The permittee and/or its contractor shall contact the DCM Transportation Project Field Representative by phone at (252) 955-4191 or by email at greg.daisey@deq.nc.gov to request a preconstruction conference prior to project initiation [G.S 113A-120(b); 07J .0209(a)].
- The permittee shall install and maintain at their expense any signal lights or signals prescribed by the U.S. Coast Guard, through regulation or otherwise, on the authorized facilities. At a minimum, permanent reflectors shall be attached to the temporary mooring piles in order to make them more visible during hours of darkness or inclement weather [G.S. 113-229(e); 07H .0208(a)(2)(G); 07J .0209(a)].
- If it is determined that additional permanent and/or temporary impacts are necessary that are not shown on the attached workplan drawing or described in the authorized permit application, a permit modification and/or additional authorization from DCM shall be required. In addition, any changes in the approved plan may also require a permit modification and/or additional authorization from DCM. The permittee shall contact a representative of DCM prior to commencement of any such activity for this determination and any permit modification [07J .0201].
- All conditions and stipulations of the active permit remain in force under this Minor Modification unless specifically altered herein [07J .0209(a)].
- MOTE: This Minor Modification does not eliminate the need to obtain any additional permits, approvals or authorizations that may be required. This includes approval, if required, from the N.C. Division of Water Resources, the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers and the U.S. Coast Guard.
- NOTE: This Minor Modification shall be attached to the original of Permit No. 136-23, which was issued on 11/30/23, and copies of both documents shall be readily available on site when a Division representative inspects the project for compliance.
- **NOTE:** A minor modification application processing fee of \$100 was received by DCM for this project.




















