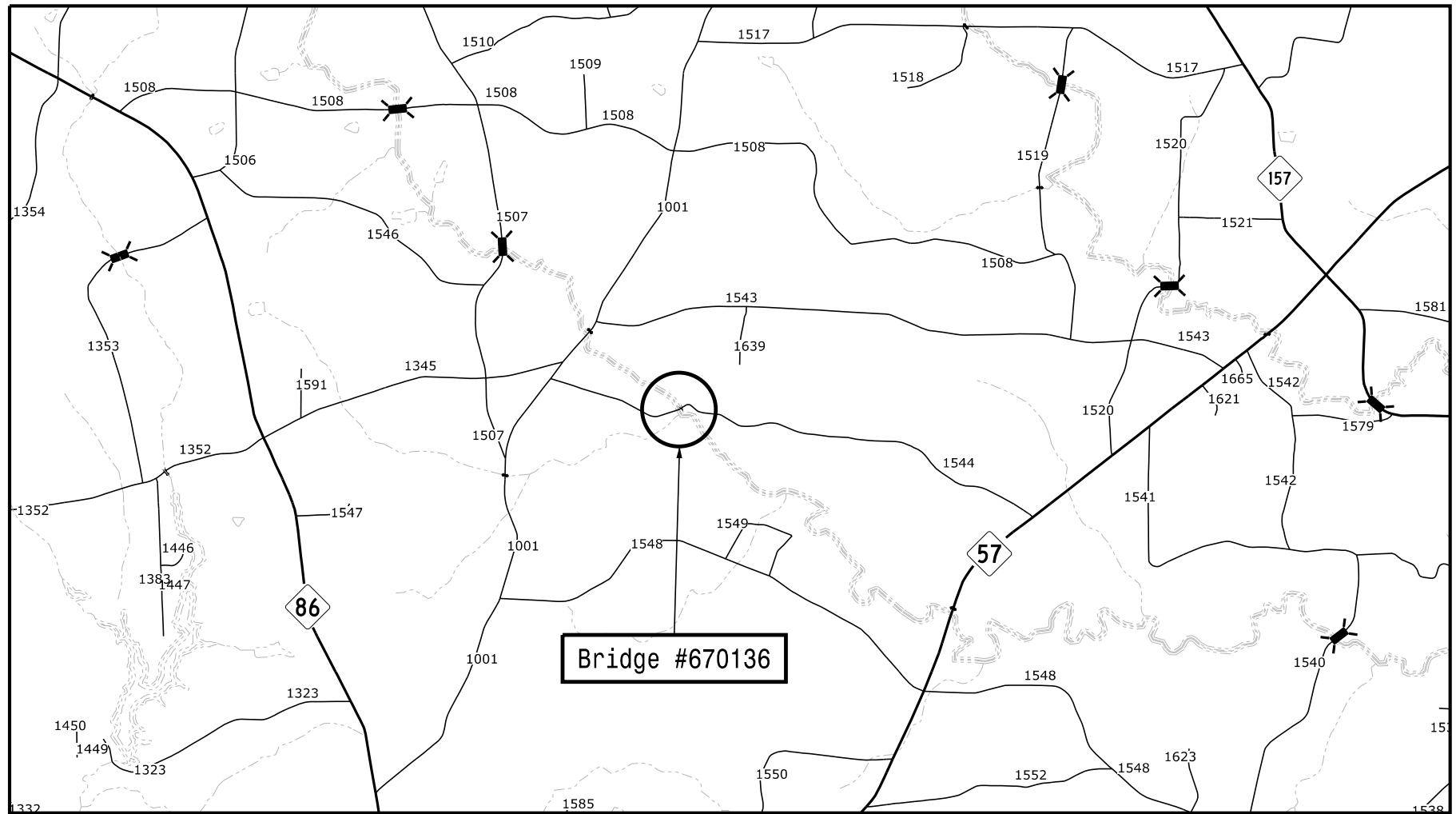

Cross Section SR 1544 is classified as a local roadway, therefore it is recommended that
the minimum cross section follow the NCDOT "R-R-R Guide" with a
minimum of 10 foot lane widths and 3 foot shoulder widths (6 foot graded
shoulder width where guardrail is to be installed).

Crash History and
Safety Considerations Two crashes have been reported in the vicinity of the bridge from 1/1/2002
to 12/31/2011 (10 years). Both crashes involved hitting the bridge rail face,
drivers travelling southwest, and were PDO only. One crash occurred
during icy conditions and the other while the driver was travelling 50 mph.

Comments Tight curve east of bridge limits bridge speed.
One object marker not present on westbound bridge approach.
Bridge pavement in poor condition, wooden bridge deck visible.
