Pam,

It is my understanding that all of the above described bridges will be replaced with bridges. No permit will be required if the bridge replacement projects do not involve a discharge of fill material into waters of the United States. If the project will require a discharge of fill material into waters of the United States, the projects will likely all qualify for NWP 3. Based on the information in the Field Scoping Meeting Worksheets, the water body at Bridge number 157 in Montgomery County is classified as an ORW, therefore DOT will have to submit a PCN if a permit is required. A PCN will be required for Bridge number 6 in Scotland County if the project "may affect" the RCW.

Also, I have to correct the record from record regarding Bridge number 93 over Dry Creek in Richmond County. A PCN will be required for this project given that rip-rap will be added and placed in Water of the United States. A PCN is required for any project under NWP 3 that involves the addition of rip-rap in Waters of the United States.
