Project Description: Replace Bridge No. 228 over Suck Branch on SR 1320 (Williamson St.)

SUMMARY OF CULTURAL RESOURCES REVIEW*Brief description of review activities, results of review, and conclusions:*

Review of HPO quad maps, HPO GIS information, historic designations roster, and indexes was undertaken on June 25, 2012. Based on this review, there are no existing NR, SL, LD, DE, or SS properties in the Area of Potential Effects, which is 75' from the centerline each way and 300' from each end of the bridge. There is one structure within the APE for this project, 220 Williamson Street, which is southeast of the bridge location. Montgomery County GIS/Tax information shows that the house was built in 1996, and Bing Maps Birds Eye View confirms that the house is under fifty years of age. There are no National Register listed or eligible properties within the APE, and no survey is required. Bridge No. 228 is not within the Historic Bridge Inventory. If design plans change, additional review will be required.

Brief Explanation of why the available information provides a reliable basis for reasonably predicting that there are no unidentified historic properties in the APE:

HPO quad maps and GIS information recording NR, SL, LD, DE, and SS properties for the Montgomery County survey, Montgomery County GIS/Tax information, Google Maps, and Bing Maps Birds Eye View are considered valid for the purposes of determining the likelihood of historic resources being present. There are no National Register listed or eligible properties within the APE and no survey is required.
