Project Description: **Replace Bridge No. 93 on SR 1148 (Grassy Island Road) over Dry Creek (no off-site detour planned).**

SUMMARY OF CULTURAL RESOURCES REVIEW

Brief description of review activities, results of review, and conclusions: HPOWeb reviewed on 20 July 2012 and yielded no NR, SL, DE, SS, or LD properties in the Area of Potential Effects (APE). Richmond County current GIS mapping, aerial photography, and tax information indicated a wooded APE (viewed 20 July 2012). The APE intersects large parcels to the NW and NE containing several pre- and post-1960 resources located 1500 feet and more from the project area. Constructed in 1958, Bridge No. 93 is a 29-foot-long, single-span, steel, stringer/multi-beam bridge and is not eligible for the National Register according to the NCDOT Historic Bridge Survey as it is not historically, architecturally, or technologically significant. Google Maps "Street View" confirmed absence of critical historic structures/landscapes in APE (viewed 20 July 2012).

No architectural survey is required for the project as currently defined.

Brief Explanation of why the available information provides a reliable basis for reasonably predicting that there are no unidentified historic properties in the APE: APE extends 300 feet from either end of the existing bridge (NE-SW) and 100 feet to either side of the SR 1148 (Grassy Island Road) centerline (SE-NW) to encompass proposed construction activities. County GIS/tax materials and other visuals support the absence of significant architectural resources. No National Register-listed or other critical properties are located within the APE, including the Federal permit area.

Should any design elements, including detour improvements, of the project change, please notify NCDOT Historic Architecture as additional review may be necessary.

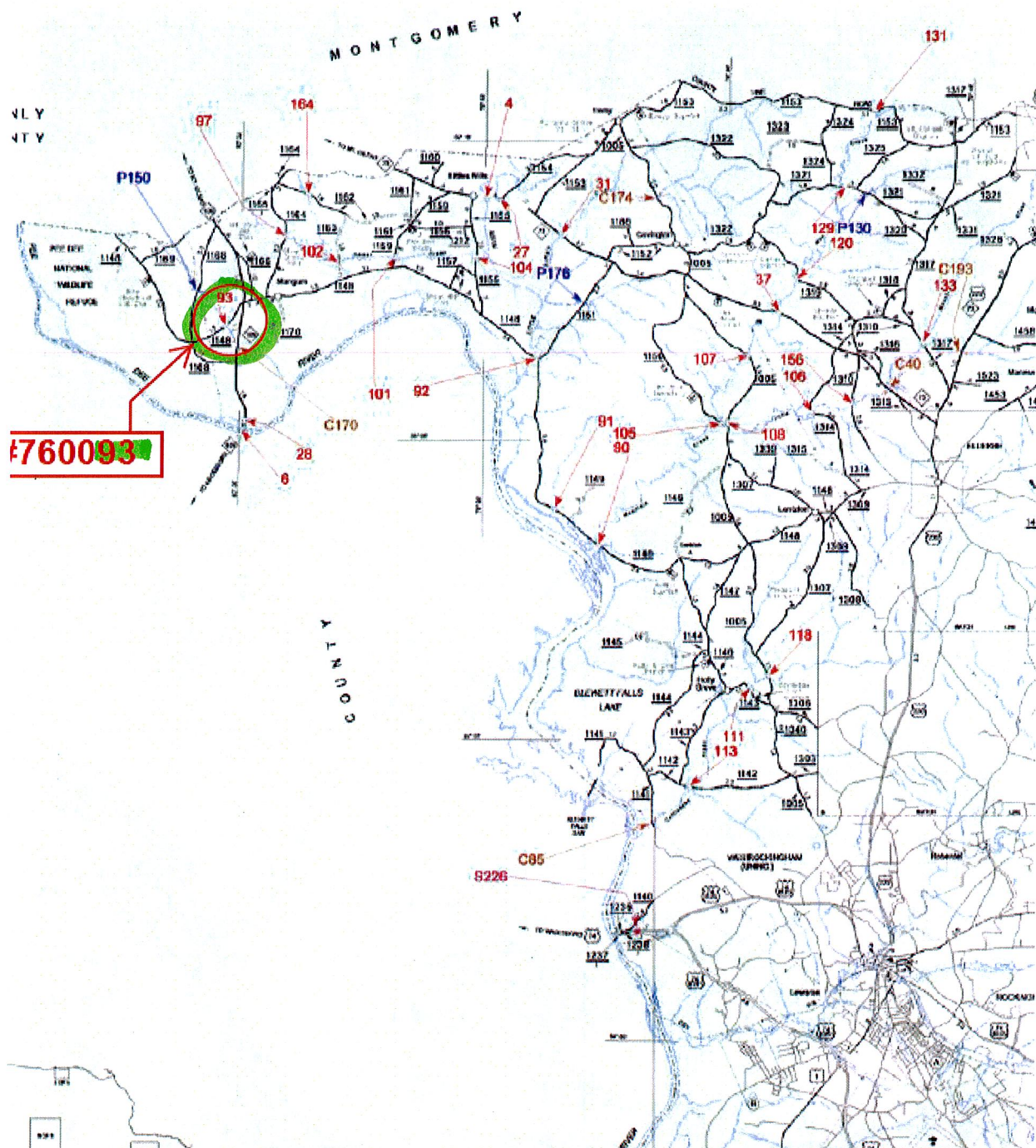
