Project Description: Replace Bridge No. 6 over Gum Swamp Creek on SR 1001 (Marston Rd).

SUMMARY OF CULTURAL RESOURCES REVIEW*Brief description of review activities, results of review, and conclusions:*

Review of HPO quad maps, HPO GIS information, historic designations roster, and indexes was undertaken on June 25, 2012. Based on this review, there are no existing NR, SL, LD, DE, or SS properties in the Area of Potential Effects, which is 75' from the centerline each way and 300' from each end of the bridge. South of the bridge location is a group of mobile homes and a manufactured home constructed in 2006, based on Scotland County GIS/Tax information. These structures are outside of the APE. Northwest of the bridge is 23500 Marston Rd. (PIN 02-0319-01-066), a two-story frame house built in 1989. The house is not eligible for National Register listing under Criteria Consideration G. In addition, Bridge No. 6 is not NR eligible based on the NCDOT Historic Bridge Inventory. There are no National Register listed or eligible properties within the APE and no survey is required. If design plans change, additional review will be required.

Brief Explanation of why the available information provides a reliable basis for reasonably predicting that there are no unidentified historic properties in the APE:

HPO quad maps and GIS information recording NR, SL, LD, DE, and SS properties for the Scotland County survey, Scotland County GIS/Tax Information, and Google Maps are considered valid for the purposes of determining the likelihood of historic resources being present. There are no National Register listed or eligible properties within the APE and no survey is required.

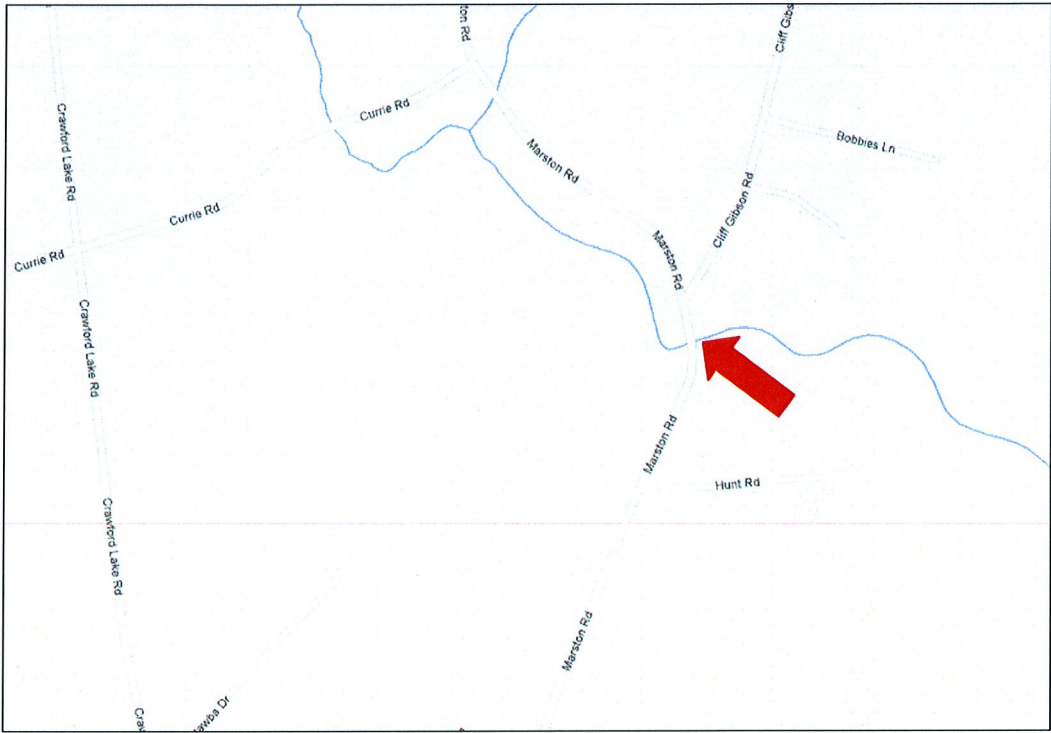

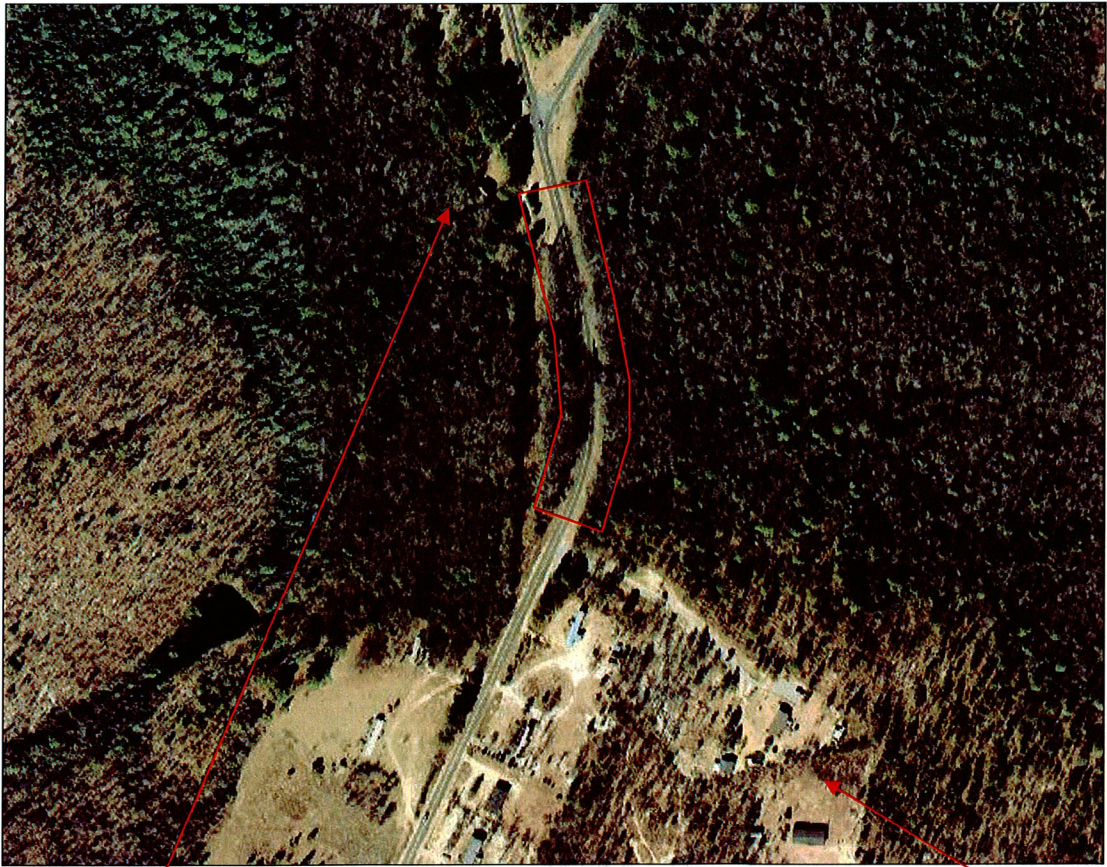

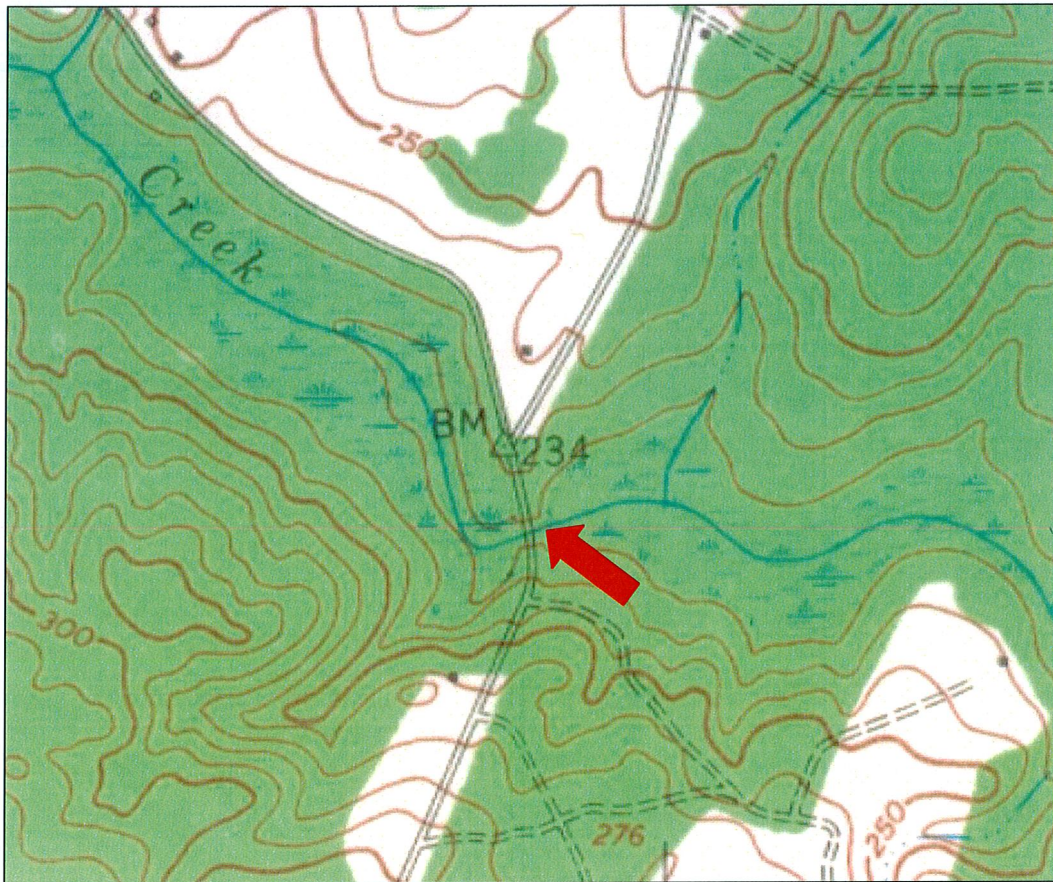
