Project Description: Replace Bridge No. 11 over Jordan's Creek on SR 1324 (Snead Town Rd).

SUMMARY OF CULTURAL RESOURCES REVIEW*Brief description of review activities, results of review, and conclusions:*

Review of HPO quad maps, HPO GIS information, historic designations roster, and indexes was undertaken on June 25, 2012. Based on this review, there are no existing NR, SL, LD, DE, or SS properties in the Area of Potential Effects, which is 75' from the centerline each way and 300' from each end of the bridge. There are no structures within the APE based on aerial imagery and Google Maps Street View. A 1957 Quad Map shows a structure southeast of the bridge; aerial views and Google Maps Street View confirm that it is no longer standing. There are no National Register listed or eligible properties within the APE, and no survey is required. In addition, Bridge No. 11 is not NR eligible based on the NCDOT Historic Bridge Inventory. If design plans change, additional review will be required.

Brief Explanation of why the available information provides a reliable basis for reasonably predicting that there are no unidentified historic properties in the APE:

HPO quad maps and GIS information recording NR, SL, LD, DE, and SS properties for the Scotland County survey, Scotland County GIS/Tax information, Google Maps Street View and Bing Maps Birds Eye View are considered valid for the purposes of determining the likelihood of historic resources being present. There are no National Register listed or eligible properties within the APE and no survey is required.

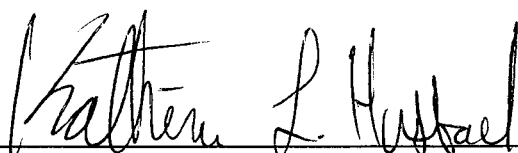
