Description of review activities, results, and conclusions:

Review of HPO quad maps, HPO GIS information, historic designations roster, and indexes was undertaken on September 13, 2013. Based on this review, there are no existing NR, SL, LD, DE, or SS properties in the Area of Potential Effects, which is 75' from the centerline each way and 300' from each end of the bridge. There is a c. 1930 house and outbuilding southwest of the bridge location and a survey was required.

The house southwest of the bridge, 1326 Mountain Park Road, is a one-story frame house built c. 1930. A one-story garage addition and one-story sunroom are attached to the southwest and northeast elevation respectively. A detached garage is northwest of the house. The house is unremarkable and not eligible for National Register listing. In addition, Bridge NO. 19 is not eligible for listing based on the NCDOT Historic Bridge Inventory. There are no National Register listed or eligible properties within the APE. If design plans change, additional review will be required.

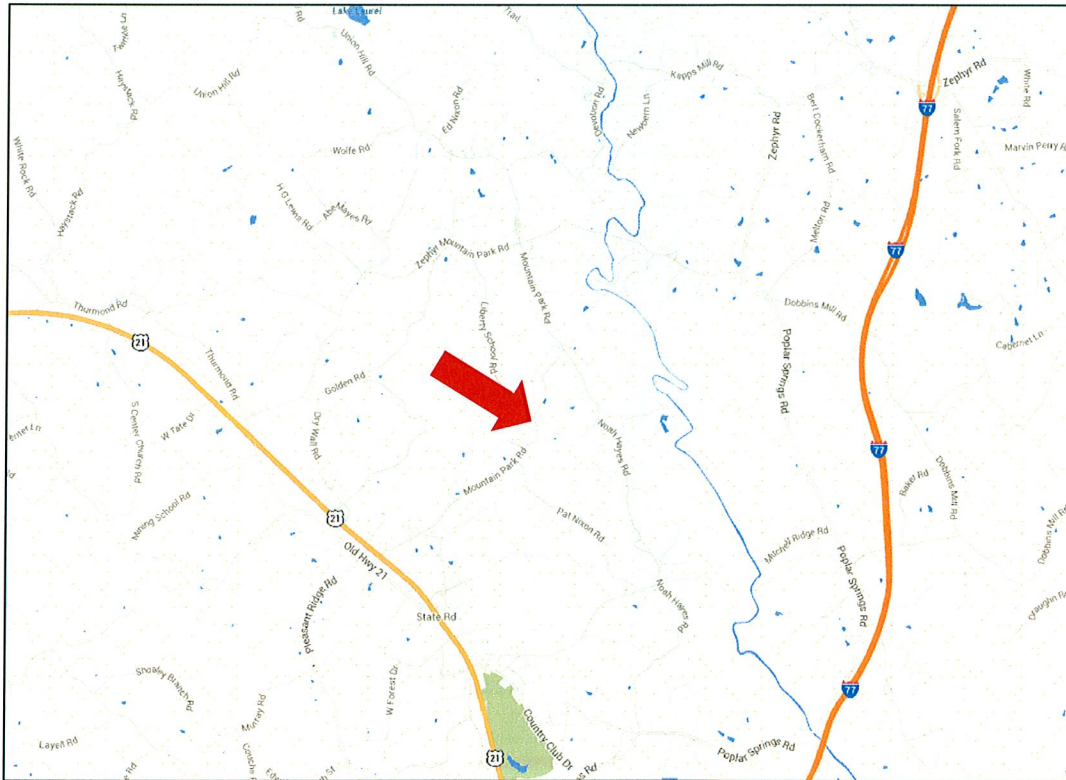
