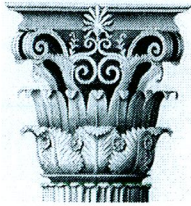

SUMMARY OF HISTORIC ARCHITECTURE AND LANDSCAPES REVIEW

Description of review activities, results, and conclusions: HPOWeb reviewed on 13 September 2013 and yielded no NR, SL, LD, DE, or SS properties in the Area of Potential Effects (APE). Rutherford County current GIS mapping, aerial photography, and tax information indicated an APE of cultivated fields and woodland containing resources dating mostly from the mid-twentieth to early twenty-first centuries (viewed 13 September 2013). Approximately 330 feet northwest of the existing bridge on a property intersected by the APE is an unexceptional circa-1950 house, remodeled in the 1960s. Constructed in 1975, Bridge No. 195 is neither included in the NCDOT Historic Bridge Survey, nor representative of any distinctive engineering or aesthetic type. Google Maps "Street View" confirmed the absence of critical historic structures and landscapes in the APE (viewed 13 September 2013).

No architectural survey is required for the project as currently defined.

Why the available information provides a reliable basis for reasonably predicting that there are no unidentified significant historic architectural or landscape resources in the project area: APE extends 350 feet from either end of the existing bridge (E-W) (and 175 feet to either side (N-S) of the SR 1700 (Cane Creek Road) intersection with US 64) and 100 feet to either side of the SR 1700 (Cane Creek Road) centerline (N-S) to encompass proposed construction activities. The comprehensive county architectural survey (1979) and related publication, as well as later additions, include no properties in the APE (Kim Merkel, *The Historic Architecture of Rutherford County* (Rutherfordton, NC: Rutherford County Arts Council, 1983)). County GIS/tax materials and other visuals support the absence of significant architectural and landscape resources in the APE. No National Register-listed properties are located within the APE, including the Federal permit area.

Should any design elements, including detour improvements, of the project change, please notify NCDOT Historic Architecture as additional review may be necessary.

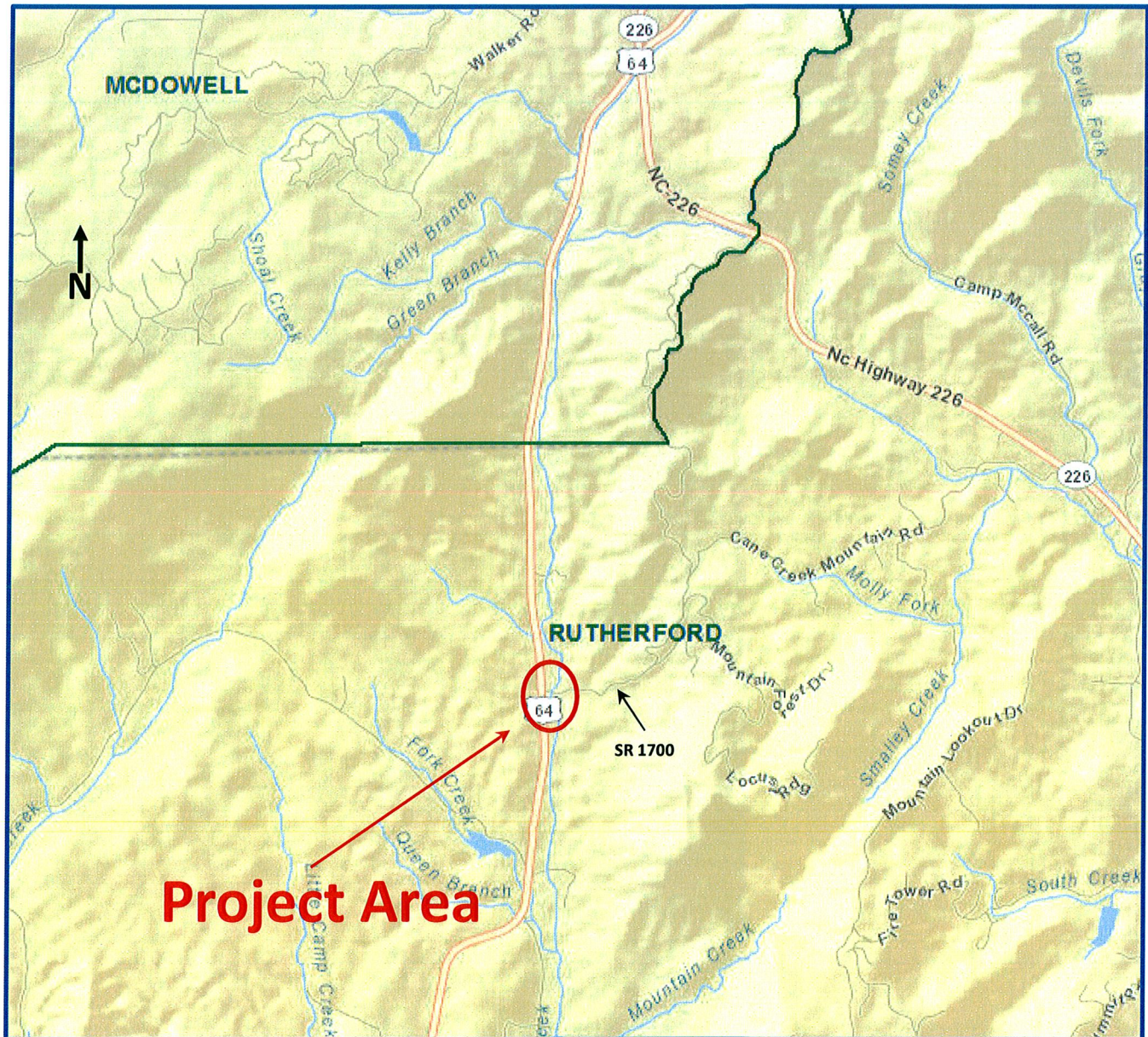
