SUMMARY OF HISTORIC ARCHITECTURE AND LANDSCAPES REVIEW

Description of review activities, results, and conclusions:

Review of HPO quad maps, HPO GIS information, historic designations roster, and indexes was undertaken on August 19, 2013. Based on this review, there are no existing NR, SL, LD, DE, or SS properties in the Area of Potential Effects, which is 75' from the centerline each way and 300' from each end of the bridge. There are several properties over fifty years of age within the APE, however Google Maps Street View confirms that there are no National Register eligible properties. A small, one-story frame building directly south of the bridge is unremarkable, as is a two-story frame house southeast of the bridge location (3995 Hemphill Rd.). A one-story manufactured home is located north of the bridge, it is unremarkable and not NR eligible. Bridge NO. 326 is not eligible for National Register listing based on the NCDOT Historic Bridge Inventory. If design plans change, additional review will be required.

Why the available information provides a reliable basis for reasonably predicting that there are no unidentified significant historic architectural or landscape resources in the project area:

HPO quad maps and GIS information recording NR, SL, LD, DE, and SS properties for the Haywood County survey and Google Maps are considered valid for the purposes of determining the likelihood of historic resources being present. There are no National Register listed or eligible properties within the APE and no survey is required.

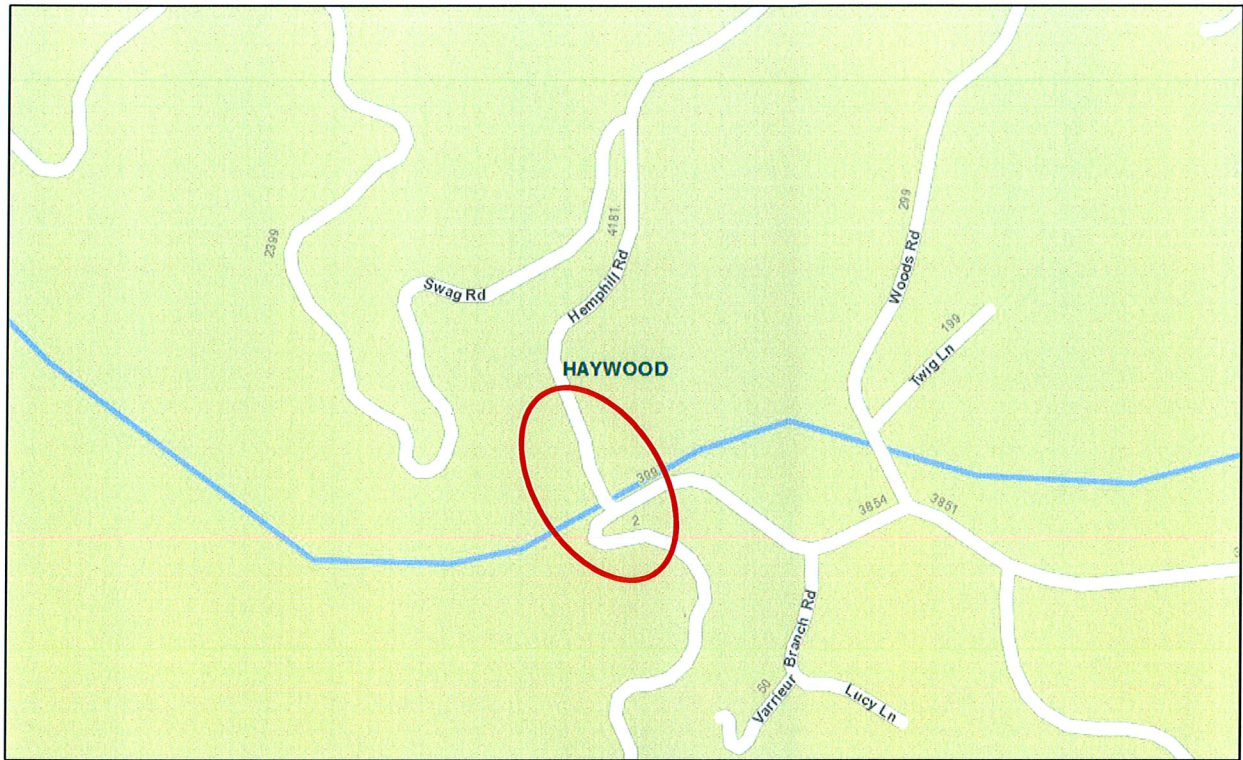
