SUMMARY OF HISTORIC ARCHITECTURE AND LANDSCAPES REVIEW

Description of review activities, results, and conclusions:

Review of HPO quad maps, HPO GIS information, historic designations roster, and indexes was undertaken on August 20, 2013. Based on this review, there are no existing NR, SL, LD, DE, or SS properties in the Area of Potential Effects, which is 75' from the centerline each way and 300' from each end of the bridge. There is one structure within the vicinity of the bridge, 2129 Moses Creek Road. The house, built 1960 based on Jackson County GIS/Tax information, is 700' northwest of the bridge location and will not be affected by this project. It falls outside of the APE. Bridge No. 103 is not eligible for National Register listing. There are no National Register listed or eligible properties and no survey is required. If design plans change, additional review will be required.

Why the available information provides a reliable basis for reasonably predicting that there are no unidentified significant historic architectural or landscape resources in the project area:

HPO quad maps and GIS information recording NR, SL, LD, DE, and SS properties for the Jackson County survey, Jackson County GIS/Tax information, and Google Maps are considered valid for the purposes of determining the likelihood of historic resources being present. There are no National Register listed or eligible properties within the APE and no survey is required.

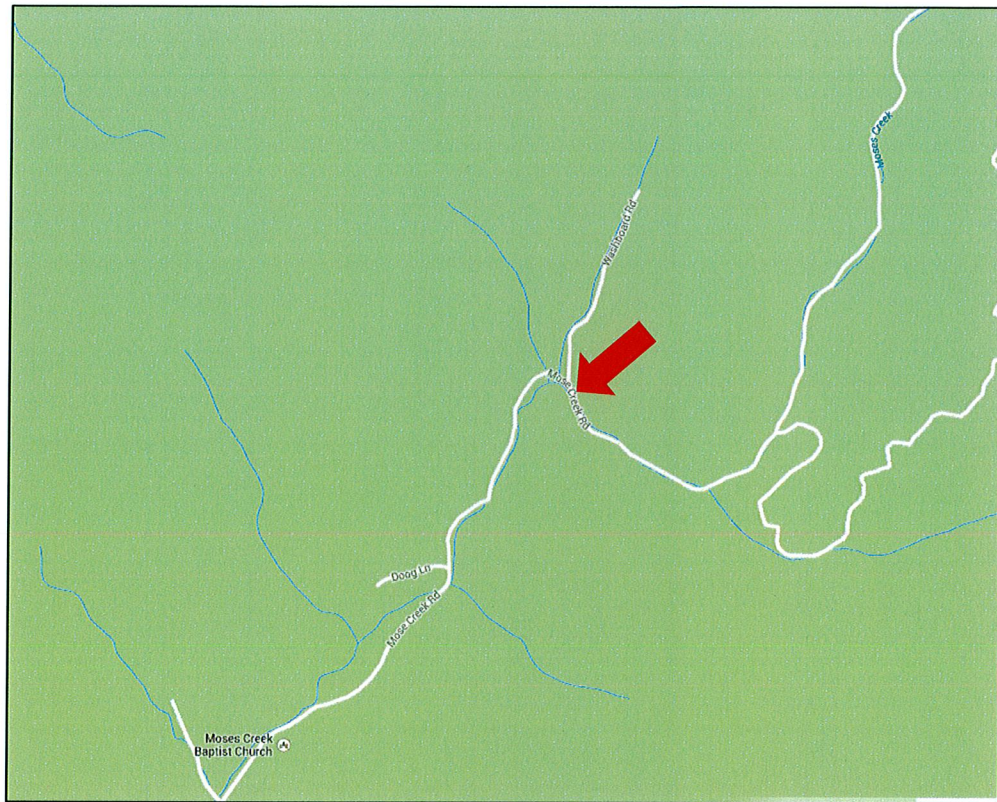
