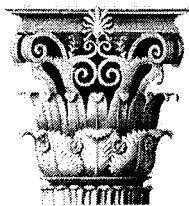

Description of review activities, results, and conclusions:

Review of HPO quad maps, HPO GIS information, historic designations roster, and indexes was undertaken on September 4, 2013. Based on this review, there are no existing NR, SL, LD, DE, or SS properties in the Area of Potential Effects, which is 75' from the centerline each way and 300' from each end of the bridge. There is a house over fifty years of age east of the bridge and within the APE and a survey was required.

All structures within the APE were assessed, and there are no properties eligible for National Register listing within the APE as the early twentieth century one-story frame house and one-story frame house constructed in 1963 are unremarkable. Bridge No. 182 is not eligible for National Register listing. There are no National Register listed or eligible properties. If design plans change, additional review will be required.

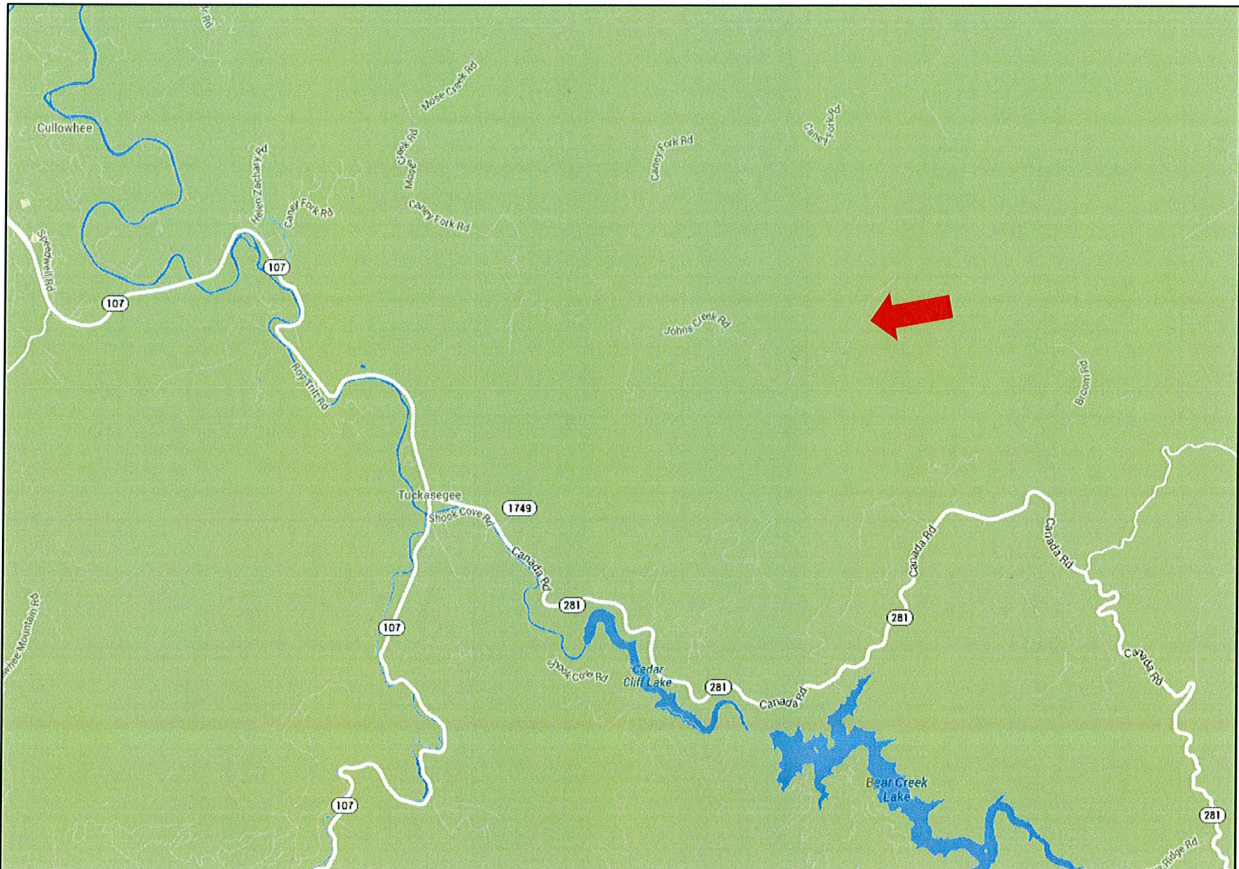

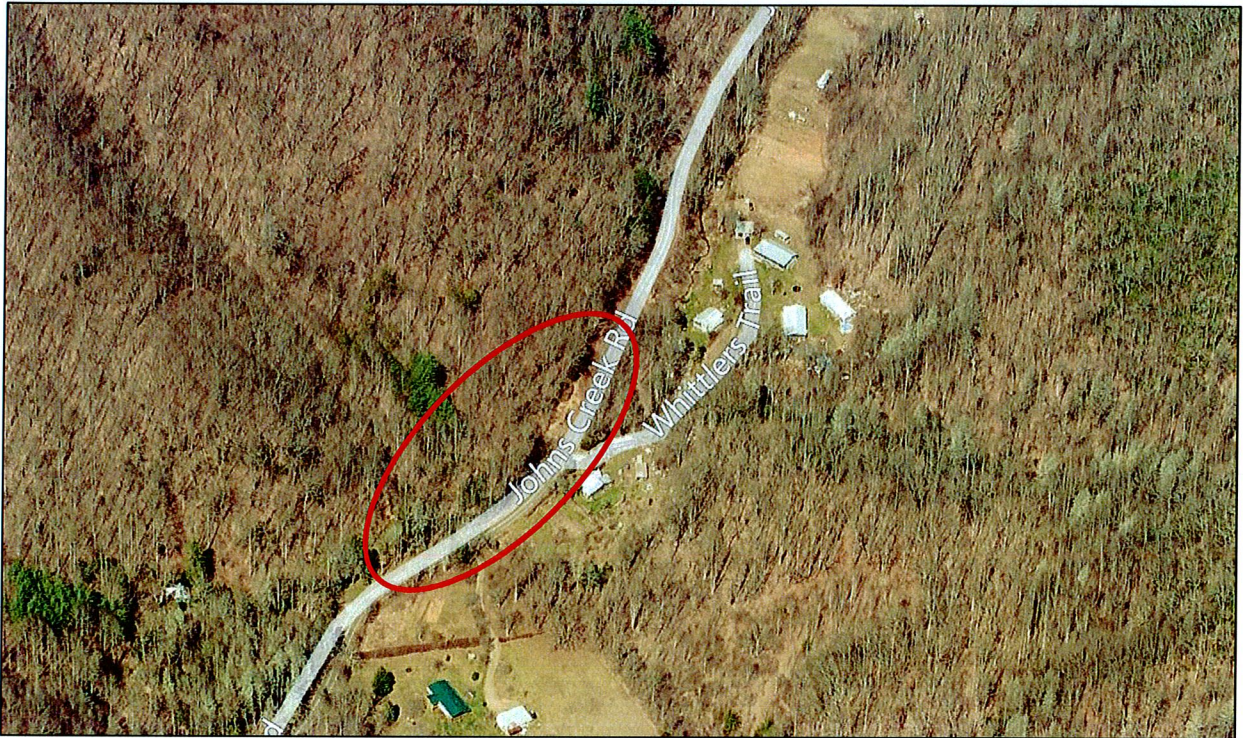
