Description of review activities, results, and conclusions:

Review of HPO quad maps, HPO GIS information, historic designations roster, and indexes was undertaken on September 4, 2013. Based on this review, there are no existing NR, SL, LD, DE, or SS properties in the Area of Potential Effects, which is 75' from the centerline each way and 300' from each end of the bridge. There is a house over fifty years of age east of the bridge and within the APE and a survey will be required.

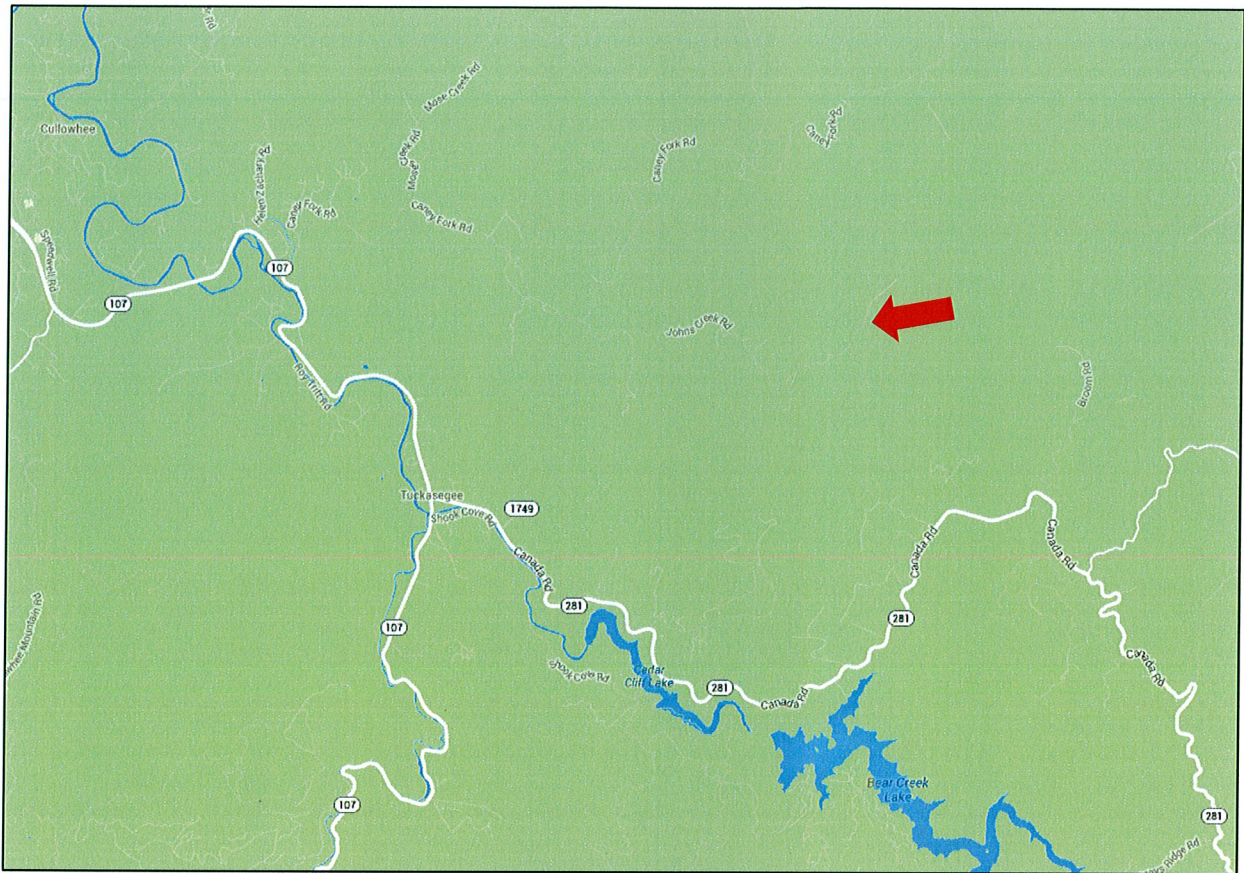
