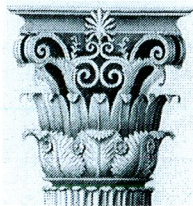

SUMMARY OF HISTORIC ARCHITECTURE AND LANDSCAPES REVIEW

DESCRIPTION OF REVIEW ACTIVITIES, RESULTS, AND CONCLUSIONS: HPOWeb reviewed on 8 February 2016 and yielded no NR, SL, LD, DE, or SS properties in the Area of Potential Effects (APE). Cumberland and Sampson Counties' current GIS mapping, aerial photography, and tax information indicated a predominantly wooded APE, which intersects several parcels containing resources dating to the late-twentieth and early-twenty-first centuries (viewed 8 February 2016). Constructed in 1959, Bridge No. 45 is not eligible for the National Register according to the NCDOT Historic Bridge Survey as it is neither aesthetically nor technologically significant. Google Maps "Street View" confirmed the absence of significant architectural and landscape resources in APE (8 February 2016).

No architectural survey is required for the project as currently defined.

WHY THE AVAILABLE INFORMATION PROVIDES A RELIABLE BASIS FOR REASONABLY PREDICTING THAT THERE ARE NO UNIDENTIFIED SIGNIFICANT HISTORIC ARCHITECTURAL OR LANDSCAPE RESOURCES IN THE PROJECT AREA: APE extends 400 feet from each end of the existing bridge (N-S) and 100 feet to either side of the existing SR 2030 (Hollow Bridge Road) center line (E-W) to encompass proposed construction. Comprehensive architectural surveys of the counties (Cumberland-1970s; Sampson-1979, Tom Butchko, *An Inventory of Historic Architecture, Sampson County, North Carolina* (Clinton: City of Clinton, 1981)) and later additions record no properties in the APE. County GIS/tax materials and other visuals support the absence of significant architectural and landscape resources. No National Register-listed properties are located within the APE.

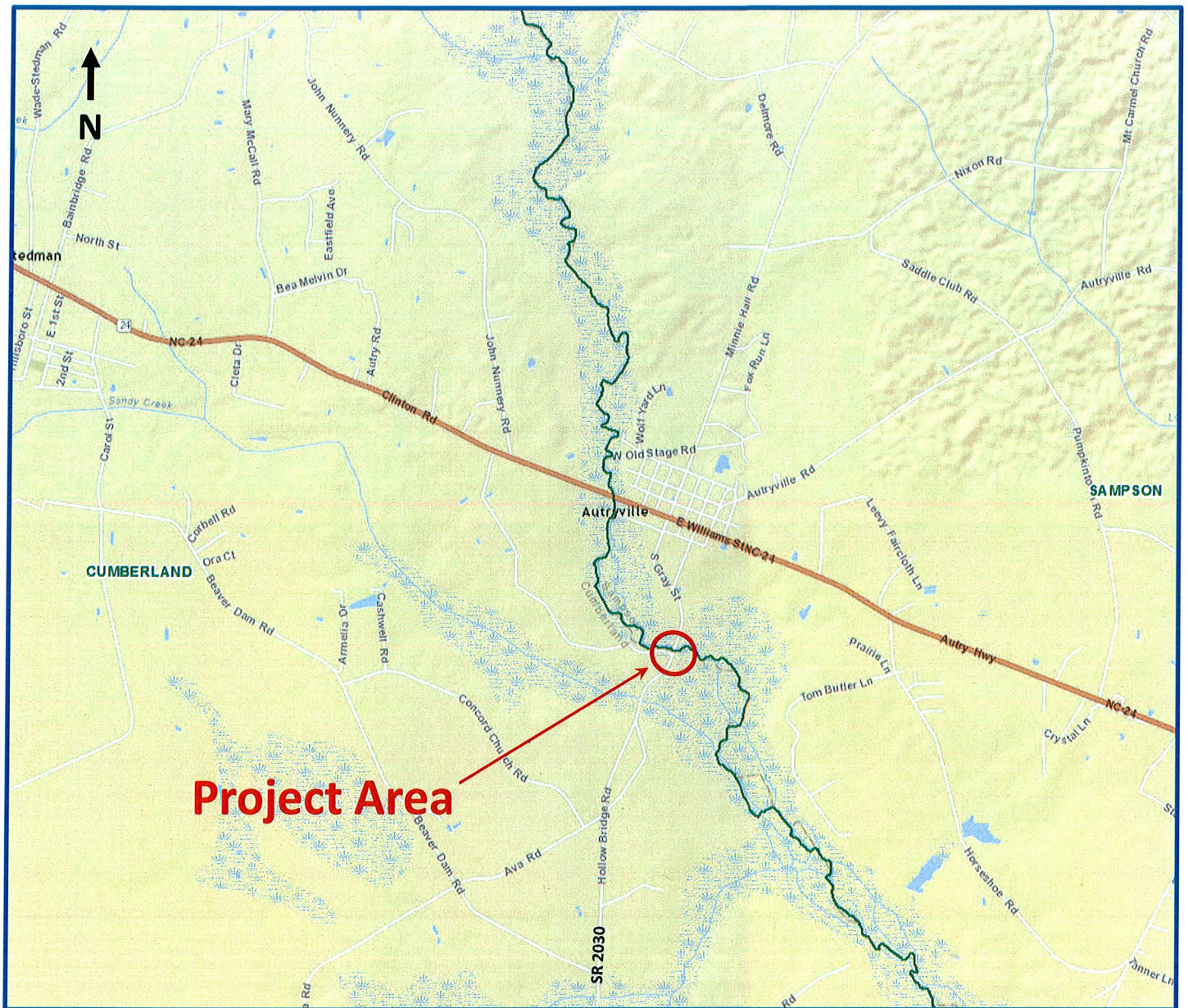
