SUMMARY OF HISTORIC ARCHITECTURE AND LANDSCAPES REVIEW

Description of review activities, results, and conclusions:

Review of HPO quad maps, HPO GIS information, historic designations roster, and indexes was undertaken on October 28, 2016. Based on this review, there are no existing NR, SL, LD, DE, or SS properties in the Area of Potential Effects, which is 300' from each end of the bridge and 75' from the centerline each way. There is one property within the APE, 990 Dillard Road. The two-story frame I-House was built c. 1898/1910. Since then, several additions have been built on the rear of the house, and new roofing, siding, and porch foundation have been added based on aerial imagery and tax information/image. The house is not a distinct example of the type; for example, the Stephen Ward House (AH0236) also in Ashe County was built within the time period yet retains original materials and is therefore a more representative example of the type. When the house was evaluated, several comparative, intact examples within the region were identified. The house at 990 Dillard Road is not eligible for NR listing as it does not have sufficient integrity. A survey site, the Frank & Sally Dillard Farm, is nearby, however it falls outside the APE and will not be affected by this project. Bridge No. 160, built 1950, is not eligible for NR listing based on the NCDOT Historic Bridge Inventory. There are no National Register listed or eligible properties and no survey is required. If design plans change, additional review will be required.

Why the available information provides a reliable basis for reasonably predicting that there are no unidentified significant historic architectural or landscape resources in the project area:

HPO quad maps and GIS information recording NR, SL, LD, DE, and SS properties for the Ashe County survey, Ashe County GIS/Tax information, and Google Maps are considered valid for the purposes of determining the likelihood of historic resources being present. There are no National Register listed or eligible properties within the APE and no survey is required.

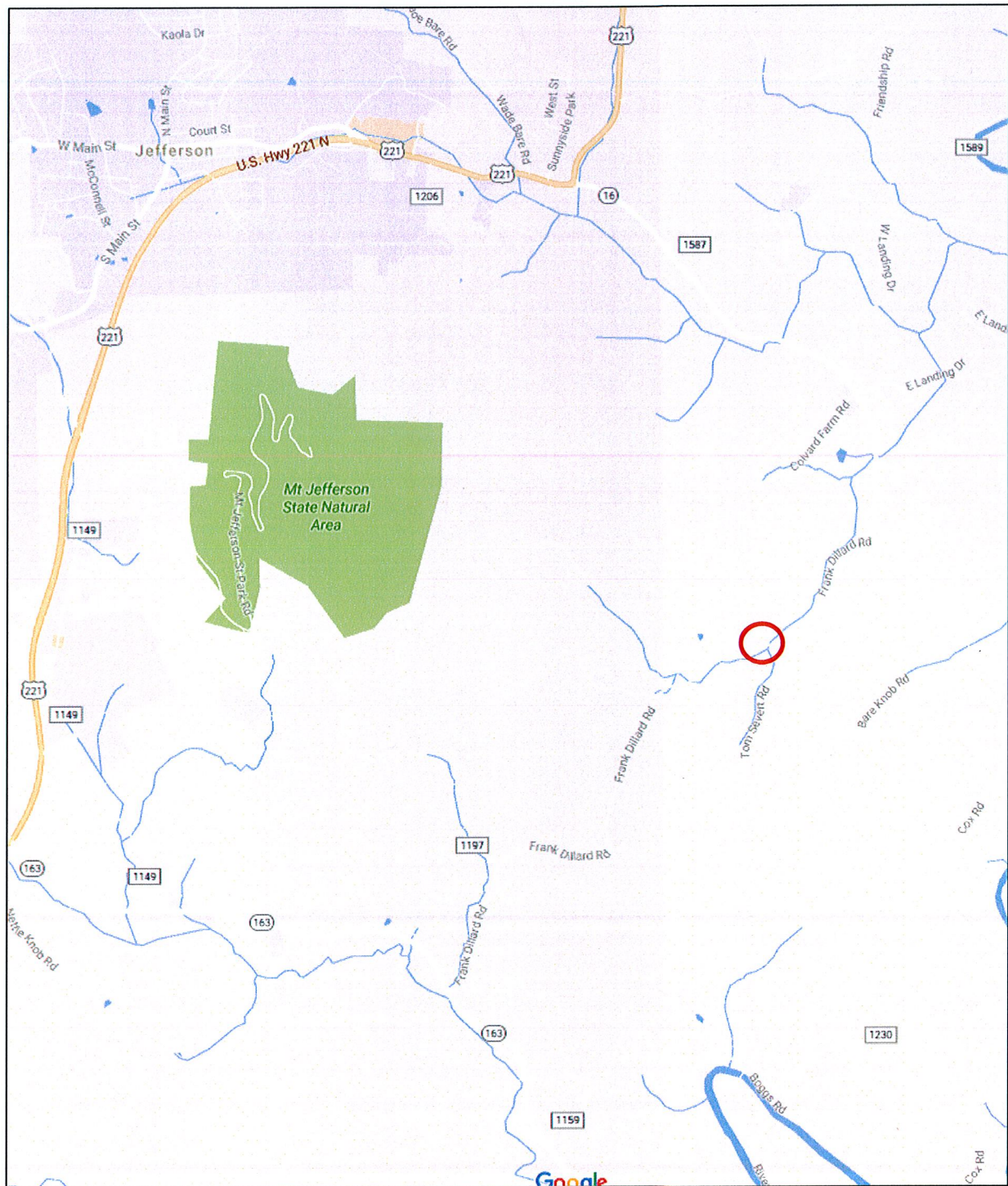
