SUMMARY OF HISTORIC ARCHITECTURE AND LANDSCAPES REVIEW

Description of review activities, results, and conclusions: HPOWeb reviewed on 21 November 2016 and yielded no NR, SL, LD, DE, and SS properties in the Area of Potential Effects (APE). Surry County current GIS mapping, aerial photography, and tax information indicated a partly wooded APE with several residential resources dating from the 1970s to the 1990s (viewed 21 November 2016). The APE intersects a parcel on which stand a small, pre-1970 barn and a springhouse, both located outside the APE and well beyond likely project impact (Parcel ID: 5948-00-78-8328). Constructed in 1968, Bridge No. 310 is not eligible for the National Register as it is neither technologically or aesthetically significant. Google Maps "Street View" confirmed the absence of critical structures and landscape resources in the APE (viewed 21 November 2016).

No architectural survey is required for the project as currently defined.

Why the available information provides a reliable basis for reasonably predicting that there are no unidentified significant historic architectural or landscape resources in the project area: APE extends 400 feet from either end of the existing bridge (N-S) and 150 feet to either side of the SR 1774 (Reeves Mill Road) centerline (E-W) to encompass proposed construction activities. The comprehensive historic architectural survey of Surry County (1981) and later studies record no properties in the APE (Laura A. W. Phillips, *Simple Treasures: the Architectural Legacy of Surry County* (Siloam, NC [?]: Surry County Historical Society, 1987)). County GIS/tax materials and other visuals clearly illustrate the absence of significant architectural resources. No National Register-listed properties are located within the APE. The project is reviewed under both GS 121-12(a) and Section 106.

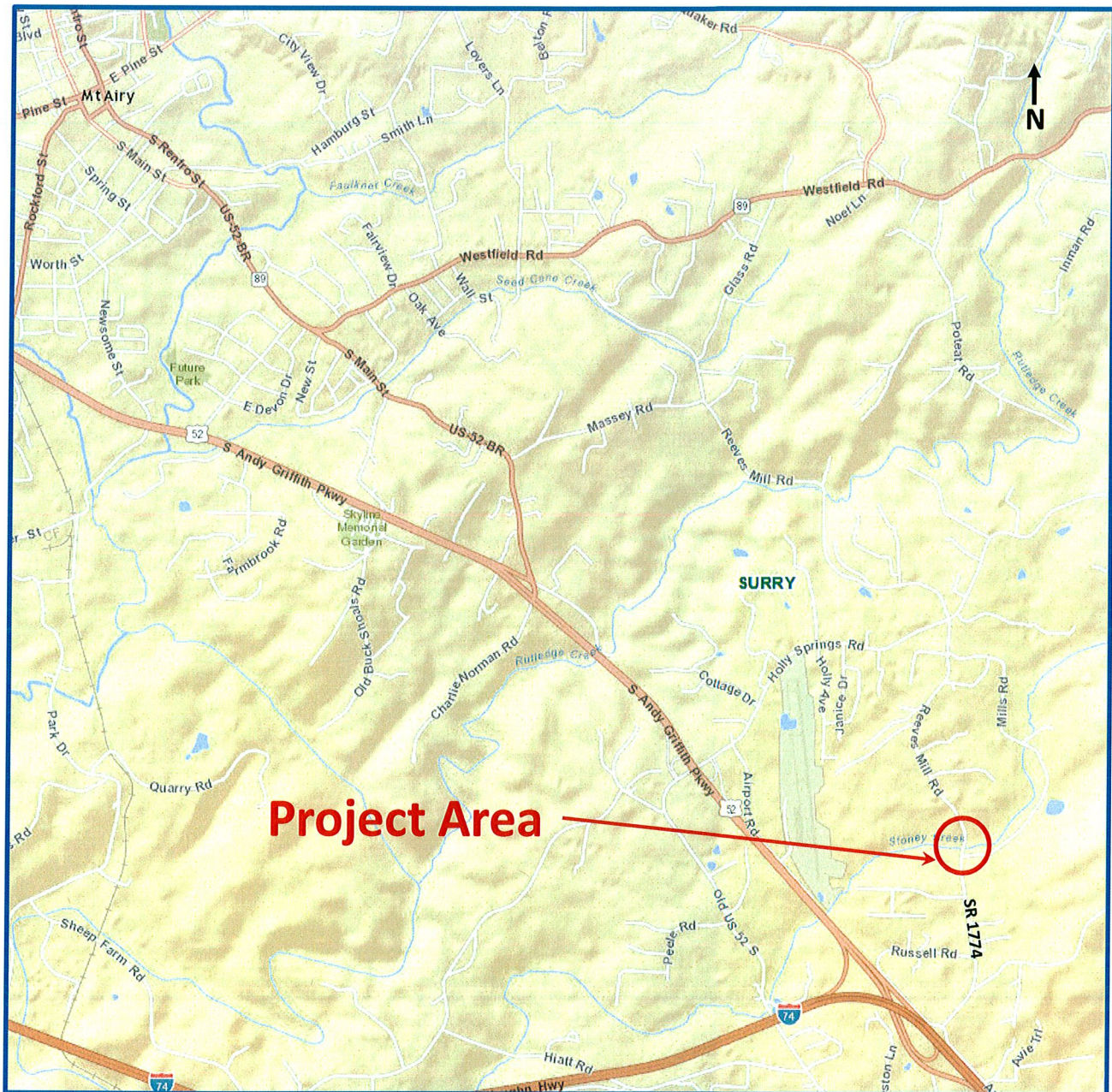
