Description of review activities, results, and conclusions:

On November 2, 2016 a search of NC HPOWEB GIS Service map and county tax data revealed that the Area of Potential Effects (APE) for this project includes a c.1900 house. An Architectural Historian conducted a site visit on November 16, 2016. The house is vacant and in a state of considerable disrepair. Most notably the roof is missing in large portions. The house is situated on a hill that rises a hundred feet or more above the bridge. The replacement of the bridge will not have an effect on the house. Avery County Bridge No. 79 was built in 1970. No historic properties will be affected by this project.

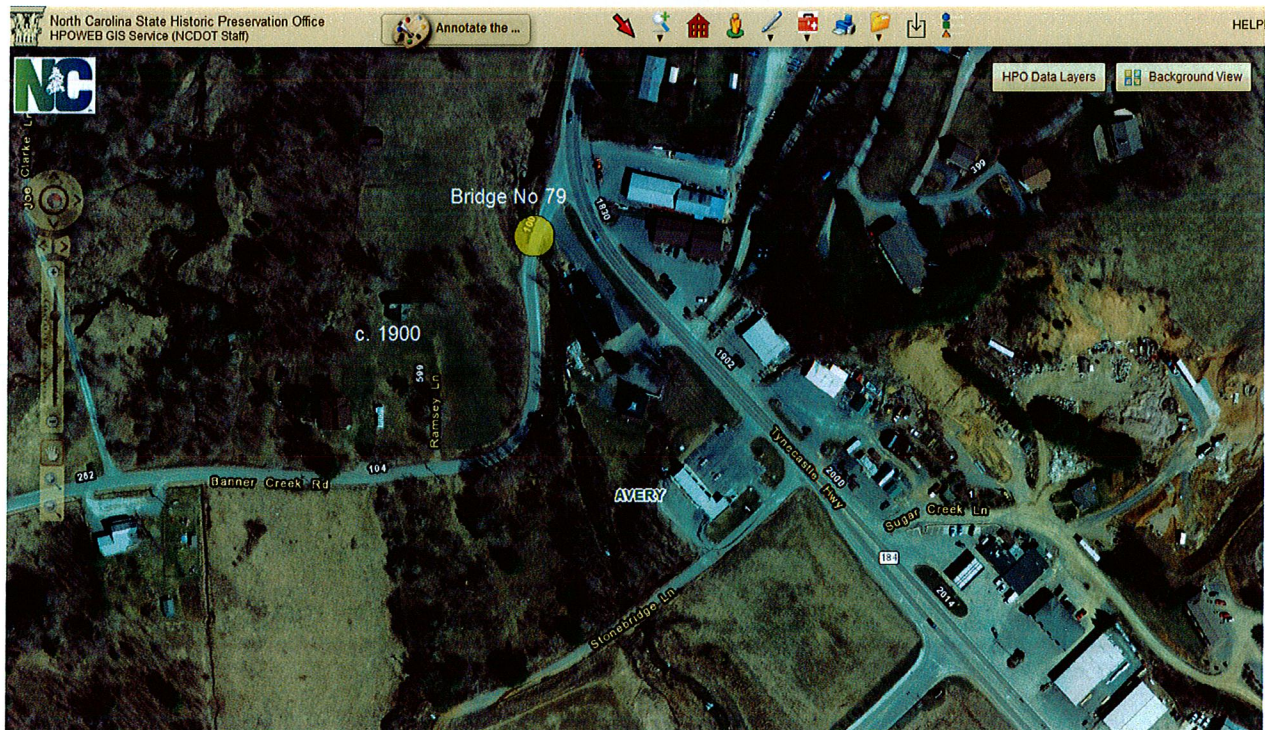
