Date of field visit: November 16, 2016

Description of review activities, results, and conclusions:

Review of HPO quad maps, relevant background reports, historic designations roster, and indexes was undertaken on November 2, 2016. Based on this review there are no NR, DE, LL, SS, or SL in the project area. Four houses over 50 years of age were determined to be within the Area of Potential Effects (APE). A site visit was conducted on November 16, 2016. Due to the topography, the 1961 ranch house located at 861 Henson Creek Road was eliminated from the APE. Distance and the pattern of the roads and in association with the bridge make it unlikely that the 1939 log house located on Homestead Lane would be affected. Neither the 1929 house at 11 Homestead Lane nor the 1947 house located at 41 Henson Creek Road meet the criteria for eligibility for National Register listing. Avery County Bridge No. 117, built in 1963, does not exemplify any distinctive engineering or aesthetic type and is not eligible for the National Register of Historic Places. No historic properties will be affected by this project.
