Description of review activities, results, and conclusions:

Review of HPO quad maps, relevant background reports, historic designations roster, and indexes was undertaken on November 8, 2016. Based on this review there are no NR, DE, LL, or SL in the project area. There are two identified historic properties in the vicinity of the project. A site visit was conducted on November 16, 2016. The house located at 163 Baird's Creek Rd (WT0716) and the barn (WT0615) were determined not eligible for National Register listing in the 2013 NCDOT Report TIP # R-2566. There are no other properties over 50 years of age that will be affected by this bridge replacement. Watauga County Bridge No. 93, constructed in 1965, does not exemplify any distinctive engineering or aesthetic type and is not eligible for the National Register of Historic Places. No historic properties will be affected by this project.

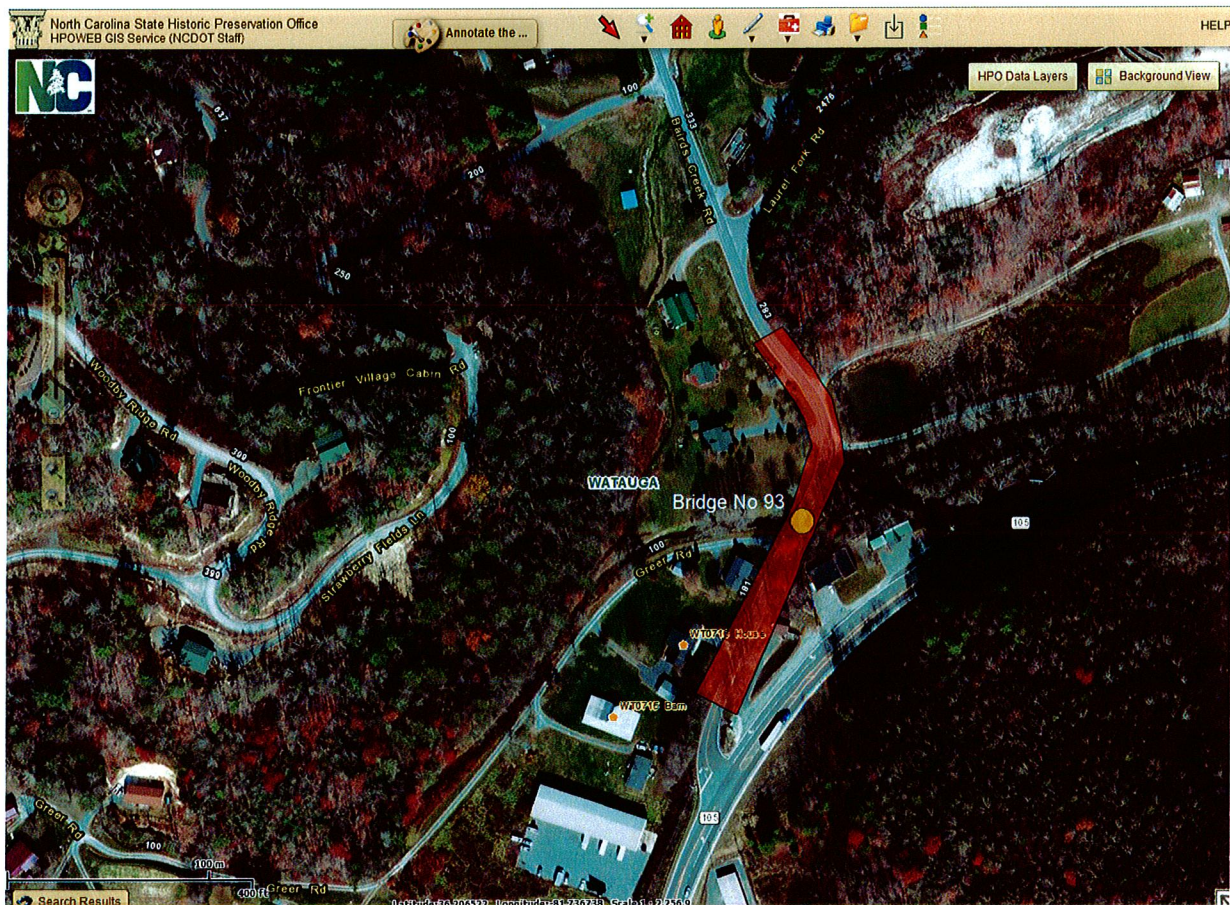
