THE FOLLOWING GENERAL NOTES APPLY AT ALL TIMES FOR THE DURATION OF THE CONSTRUCTION PROJECT, EXCEPT WHEN OTHERWISE NOTED IN THE PLAN, OR DIRECTED BY THE ENGINEER.

ADAPT THE TRAFFIC CONTROL PLANS, WHEN DIRECTED BY THE ENGINEER, TO MEET FIELD CONDITIONS AND TO PROVIDE SAFE AND EFFICIENT TRAFFIC MOVEMENT. CHANGES MAY BE REQUIRED WHEN PHYSICAL DIMENSIONS IN THE DETAIL DRAWINGS, STANDARD DETAILS AND ROADWAY DETAILS ARE NOT ATTAINABLE, OR RESULT IN DUPLICATE, OR UNDESIRED OVERLAPPING OF DEVICES. MODIFICATION MAY INCLUDE: MOVING, SUPPLEMENTING, COVERING OR REMOVAL OF DEVICES.

- 1. FOR NEW YEAR'S, BETWEEN THE HOURS OF 6:00 A.M. DECEMBER 31ST TO 6:00 P.M. JANUARY 2ND. IF NEW YEAR'S DAY IS ON A SATURDAY OR A SUNDAY, THEN UNTIL 6:00 P.M. THE FOLLOWING TUESDAY.
- 2. FOR THE "DAYTONA 500"-RACE, BETWEEN THE HOURS OF 6:00 A.M. THE FRIDAY BEFORE THE RACE AND 6:00 P.M. THE FOLLOWING MONDAY AFTER THE RACE.
- 3. FOR EASTER, BETWEEN THE HOURS OF 6:00 A.M. THURSDAY AND 6:00 P.M. MONDAY.
- 4. FOR MEMORIAL DAY, BETWEEN THE HOURS OF 6:00 A.M. FRIDAY TO 6:00 P.M. TUESDAY.
- 5. FOR INDEPENDENCE DAY, BETWEEN THE HOURS OF 6:00 A.M. THE DAY BEFORE INDEPENDENCE DAY AND 6:00 P.M. THE DAY AFTER INDEPENDENCE DAY.

IF INDEPENDENCE DAY IS ON A SATURDAY OR SUNDAY, THEN BETWEEN THE HOURS OF 6:00 A.M. THE THURSDAY BEFORE INDEPENDENCE DAY AND 6:00 P.M. THE TUESDAY AFTER INDEPENDENCE DAY.

- 6. FOR LABOR DAY, BETWEEN THE HOURS OF 6:00 A.M. FRIDAY TO 6:00 P.M. TUESDAY.
- 7. FOR THANKSGIVING, BETWEEN THE HOURS OF 6:00 A.M. TUESDAY TO 6:00 P.M. MONDAY.
- 8. FOR CHRISTMAS, BETWEEN THE HOURS OF 6:00 A.M. THE FRIDAY BEFORE THE WEEK OF CHRISTMAS DAY AND 6:00 P.M. THE FOLLOWING MONDAY AFTER THE WEEK OF CHRISTMAS.
- 9. FOR ANY EVENT THAT CREATES UNUSUALLY HIGH TRAFFIC VOLUMES, AS DIRECTED BY THE ENGINEER.
- C) DO NOT STOP TRAFFIC OR CLOSE ROADS AS FOLLOWS:

G) DO NOT CONDUCT ANY HAULING OPERATIONS AGAINST THE FLOW OF TRAFFIC OF AN OPEN TRAVELWAY UNLESS THE WORK AREA IS PROTECTED BY BARRIER, GUARDRAIL, GUIDERAIL OR OTHERWISE DIRECTED BY THE ENGINEER.

LANE AND SHOULDER CLOSURE REQUIREMENTS

- H) REMOVE LANE CLOSURE DEVICES FROM THE LANE WHEN WORK IS NOT BEING PERFORMED BEHIND THE LANE CLOSURE OR WHEN A LANE CLOSURE IS NO LONGER NEEDED, OR AS DIRECTED BY THE ENGINEER.
- I) WHEN PERSONNEL AND/OR EQUIPMENT ARE WORKING WITHIN 40 FT (12m) OF AN OPEN TRAVEL LANE, CLOSE THE NEAREST OPEN SHOULDER USING ROADWAY STANDARD DRAWING NO. 1101.04 UNLESS THE WORK AREA IS PROTECTED BY BARRIER, GUARDRAIL, OR GUIDERAIL.
- WHEN PERSONNEL AND/OR EQUIPMENT ARE WORKING ON THE SHOULDER ADJACENT TO A DIVIDED FACILITY AND WITHIN 10 FT (3m) OF AN OPEN TRAVEL LANE, CLOSE THE NEAREST OPEN TRAVEL LANE USING ROADWAY STANDARD DRAWING NO. 1101.02 UNLESS THE WORK AREA IS PROTECTED BY BARRIER, GUARDRAIL, OR GUIDERAIL.

WHEN PERSONNEL AND/OR EQUIPMENT ARE WORKING ON THE SHOULDER ADJACENT TO AN UNDIVIDED FACILITY AND WITHIN 5 FT (1.5m) OF AN OPEN TRAVEL LANE, CLOSE THE NEAREST OPEN TRAVEL LANE USING ROADWAY STANDARD DRAWING NO. 1101.02 UNLESS THE WORK AREA IS PROTECTED BY BARRIER, GUARDRAIL, OR GUIDERAIL.

- K) WHEN PERSONNEL AND/OR EQUIPMENT ARE WORKING WITHIN A LANE OF TRAVEL OF AN UNDIVIDED OR DIVIDED FACILITY, CLOSE THE LANE ACCORDING TO THE TRAFFIC CONTROL PLANS, ROADWAY STANDARD DRAWINGS OR AS DIRECTED BY THE ENGINEER. CONDUCT THE WORK SO THAT ALL PERSONNEL AND/OR EQUIPMENT REMAIN WITHIN THE CLOSED TRAVEL LANE.
- L) DO NOT WORK SIMULTANEOUSLY, ON BOTH SIDES OF AN OPEN TRAVELWAY, WITHIN THE SAME LOCATION, ON A TWO-LANE, TWO-WAY ROAD.
- M) DO NOT PERFORM WORK INVOLVING HEAVY EQUIPMENT WITHIN 15 FT (5m) OF THE EDGE OF TRAVELWAY WHEN WORK IS BEING PERFORMED BEHIND A LANE CLOSURE ON THE OPPOSITE SIDE OF THE TRAVELWAY.
- N) LANE CLOSURES SHALL BE REMOVED ON I-95 WHEN THE TRAFFIC QUEUE IN ADVANCE OF THE LANE CLOSURE AS MEASURED FROM THE MERGE TAPER REACHES 3.2 km (2 MILES). (SEE SPECIAL PROVISIONS).

DO NOT INSTALL MORE THAN ONE LANE CLOSURE, IN ANY ONE DIRECTION, ON I-95.
