General

CONTRACT TIME AND LIQUIDATED DAMAGES:

12-02-03

The date of availability for this contract is the date the Contractor begins work but not before May 2, 2005 or later than July 15, 2005.

The completion date for this contract is the date that is eighty-five (85) consecutive calendar days after and including the date of availability.

The observation period for the thermoplastic pavement markings is not a part of the work to be completed by the completion date for this contract as stated herein. Warrant the observation period by the payment and performance bond.

The liquidated damages for this contract shall be Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) per calendar day. At the preconstruction conference, the Contractor shall declare his expected date for beginning work. Should the Contractor desire to revise this date after the preconstruction conference, he shall notify the Engineer in writing at least thirty (30) days prior to the revised date.

INTERMEDIATE CONTRACT TIME NUMBER 1 AND LIQUIDATED DAMAGES:

09-16-03

The Contractor shall complete the required work of installing, maintaining, and removing the traffic control devices for lane closures and restoring traffic to the existing traffic pattern. The Contractor shall not close or narrow a lane of traffic on Maps #1 thru #4 and #6 thru #18 during the following time restrictions:

DAY AND TIME RESTRICTIONS

MONDAY THRU FRIDAY 6:00 A.M. TO 9:00 A.M. MONDAY THRU FRIDAY 4:00 P.M. TO 7:00 P.M.

In addition, the Contractor shall not close or narrow a lane of traffic on <u>All Maps</u>, detain and/or alter the traffic flow on or during holidays, holiday weekends, special events, or any other time when traffic is unusually heavy, including the following schedules:

HOLIDAY AND HOLIDAY WEEKEND LANE CLOSURE RESTRICTIONS:

- 1. For any event that creates unusually high traffic volumes, as directed by the Engineer.
- 2. For New Year's Day, between the hours of 4:00 p.m. December 31st and 9:00 a.m. January 2nd. If New Year's Day is on Saturday or Sunday, then until 9:00 a.m. the following Tuesday.
