



GENERAL NOTES

- INSTALL SIGNING WITH THE TRAFFIC FLOW, BEGINNING WITH DEVICES ON THE UPSTREAM SIDE OF TRAFFIC.
- REMOVE SIGNING AGAINST THE TRAFFIC FLOW, BEGINNING WITH DEVICES ON THE DOWNSTREAM SIDE OF TRAFFIC.
- EXTEND BUFFER SPACE SUCH THAT STOPPING SIGHT DISTANCE IS PROVIDED TO THE FLAGGER.
(REFER TO RSD 1101.11, 2 OF 4).
- DO NOT STOP TRAFFIC IN ANY ONE DIRECTION FOR MORE THAN 15 MINUTES AT A TIME.
- USE PILOT CARS WHEN DIRECTED BY THE ENGINEER.
- TRAFFIC CONTROL DEVICES ARE SHOWN FOR ONE DIRECTION OF TRAFFIC APPROACHING THE WORK ZONE; THE SAME DEVICES APPLY FOR THE OPPOSING TRAFFIC DIRECTION.
