

Embankments are man-made fills built during construction of existing roadways. Embankment material overlies the cohesive/organic sediments along -L- and adjacent roads. The embankment soils are 1 to 3 feet thick and consist of medium stiff to very stiff fine sandy silt (A-4) and generally exhibit fair to good engineering properties.
