

All utility encasement pipe shall be steel and shall comply with this table for thickness:

<u>Pipe Sizes (O.D.)</u>	<u>Wall Thickness</u>
100mm to 350mm	4.775mm
400mm to 600mm	6.35mm
750mm	7.925mm
900mm	9.525mm
1200mm	12.7mm

400mm water line for this project shall be class 50 Ductile Iron.

UTILITY CONFLICTS:

General:

The following utility companies have facilities that will be in conflict with the construction of this project:

- A. Progress Energy – Power Transmission/Distribution
- B. Embarq - Telephone
- C. Time Warner – CATV
- D. Craven County Information Technology Dept. – Fiber Optic

The conflicting facilities of these concerns will be adjusted prior to the date of availability, unless otherwise noted and are therefore listed in these special provisions for the benefit of the Contractor. All utility work listed herein will be done by the utility owners. All utilities are shown on the plans from the best available information.

The Contractor's attention is directed to Article 105.8 of the Standard Specifications.

 - 2. All facilities will be relocated by Date of Availability.
- D. Craven County Information Technology Dept. – Fiber Optic
 - 1. See "Utility By Others Plans" for utility conflicts.
 - 2. The fiber optic cable will remain in place and be adjusted as necessary.
