GENERAL

CONTRACT TIME AND LIQUIDATED DAMAGES:

The date of availability for this contract is March 15, 2010.

The completion date for this contract is **November 1, 2010**.

Except where otherwise provided by the contract, observation periods required by the contract will not be a part of the work to be completed by the completion date and/or intermediate contract times stated in the contract. The acceptable completion of the observation periods that extend beyond the final completion date shall be a part of the work covered by the performance and payment bonds.

The liquidated damages for this contract shall be Eight Hundred Dollars (\$800.00) per calendar day.

INTERMEDIATE CONTRACT TIME NUMBER 1 AND LIQUIDATED DAMAGES

The Contractor shall complete the required work of installing, maintaining, and removing the traffic control devices for lane closures and restoring traffic to the existing traffic pattern. The Contractor shall not close or narrow a lane of traffic on NC 98 and US 1A during the following time restrictions:

DAY AND TIME RESTRICTIONS

US 1A (WHEN SCHOOL IS NOT IN SESSION) AND NC 98 MONDAY THRU FRIDAY 6:00 A.M. TO 9:00 A.M. MONDAY THRU FRIDAY 4:00 P.M. TO 7:00 P.M.

US 1A (WHEN SCHOOL IS IN SESSION) MONDAY THRU FRIDAY 6:00 A.M. TO 9:00 A.M. MONDAY THRU FRIDAY 2:00 P.M. TO 7:00 P.M.

In addition, the Contractor shall not close or narrow a lane of traffic on NC 98 and US 1A, detain and/or alter the traffic flow on or during holidays, holiday weekends, special events, or any other time when traffic is unusually heavy, including the following schedules:
