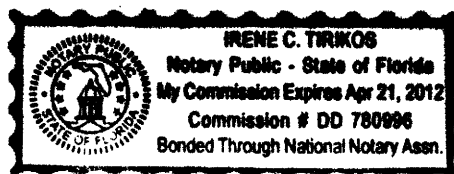

DEBARMENT CERTIFICATION OF CONTRACTOR



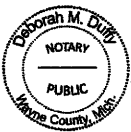
