PROJECT SPECIAL PROVISIONS
Utility Construction



I. GENERAL CONSTRUCTION REQUIREMENTS

Specifications:

The proposed utility construction shall meet the applicable requirements of the North Carolina Department of Transportation's "Standard Specifications for Roads and Structures" dated July 2006, and the following provisions.

Owner and Owner's Requirements:

The existing water and sewer systems belong to the Town of Gibsonville and the Town of Elon. The Contractor shall provide access for the owner's representatives during all phases of construction. The owner shall be notified at least two weeks prior to commencement of any work and at least one week prior to service interruption.

For work involving Gibsonville's facilities, the Contractor shall contact the Town of Gibsonville Public Works Department at (336) 449-7188. For work involving Elon's facilities, the Contractor shall contact the Town of Elon Public Works Department at (336) 584-9600.

It shall be the Contractor's responsibility to notify customers affected by necessary shut downs of the existing water or sewer systems at least 24 hours in advance.

Copies of test results shall be provided to the appropriate water or sewer system owner for any tests involving their facilities.

The Engineer and owner shall be notified in advance of any interruption of water or sewer service with ample time to make arrangements. Interruption of water or sewer service on main lines shall be limited to a maximum of four (4) hours or as approved by the Engineer.

II. COMPENSATION:

No direct payment will be made for utility construction work required by the preceding provisions, which are general requirements applying to utility construction, and all of the requirements stated will be considered incidental work, paid for at the contract unit prices of the various utility items included in the contract.

ADJUST MANHOLE:

Existing manholes raised more than 2 feet will be measured and paid for per each for the raised portion of the existing manhole exceeding a height of 2 feet.

The quantity of manholes adjusted and accepted will be measured and paid for at the contract unit price per each for "Adjust Manhole". Such price and payments will be full compensation for all labor, materials, raising the existing manhole, excavation, backfilling, and incidentals necessary to complete the work as required.

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UTILITIES BY OTHERS

General:

The following utility companies have facilities that will be in conflict with the construction of this project.

- A) Duke Energy – Power (Distribution)
- B) CenturyLink – Telephone
- C) Piedmont Natural Gas Company – Gas
- D) Time Warner Cable – Cable TV

The conflicting facilities of these concerns will be adjusted prior to the date of availability, unless otherwise noted and are therefore listed in these special provisions for the benefit of the Contractor. All utility work listed herein will be done by the utility owner. All utilities are shown on the plans from the best available information.

The Contractor's attention is directed to Article 105-8 of the Standard Specifications.

Utilities Requiring Adjustment:

- A) Duke Energy - Power (Distribution)
 - 1) See Utilities by Others Plans.
 - 2) Duke will complete their relocation work prior to the date of availability. Contact person is Mr. Steve Whittamore (336-222-5562).
- B) CenturyLink – Telephone
 - 1) See Utilities by Others Plans.
 - 2) Contact person is Mr. Brian McNiff (336-996-5999)
- C) Piedmont Natural Gas Company – Gas
 - 1) See Utilities by Others Plans.
 - 2) Piedmont will complete their work prior to the date of availability. Conflicts identified during construction will be adjusted as necessary. Piedmont Natural Gas Company will require 2 weeks notice and 1 week to complete each adjustment. Contact person is Mr. Freddie Hancock (336-222-7112)
- D) Time Warner Cable – Cable TV
 - 1) See Utilities by Others Plans.

2) Time Warner Cable will complete their relocation work prior to the date of availability. Contact person is Ms. Toni Walton (336-217-3131).

NOTE: All other utilities will remain in place and will be adjusted as necessary.
