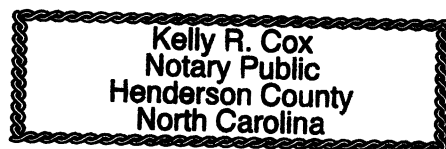

## DEBARMENT CERTIFICATION
