GENERAL CONSTRUCTION REQUIREMENTS

Specifications:

I.

The proposed utility construction shall meet the applicable requirements of the North Carolina Department of Transportation's "Standard Specifications for Roads and Structures" dated July 2006, and the following provisions.

Owner and Owner's Requirements:

The existing water and sewer systems belong to Camden County The Contractor shall provide access for the owner's representatives during all phases of construction.

For work involving Camden County's facilities, the Contractor shall contact the Camden County Public Works Department at (252) 338-1919

Existing water meters, fire hydrants, and related appurtenances which are removed from service shall become property of the Contractor, and the Contractor shall properly dispose of these items.

Test results shall be provided to Camden County for any tests involving their facilities.

The Engineer and owner shall be notified in advance of any interruption of water or sewer service with ample time to make arrangements. Interruption of water or sewer service on main lines shall be limited to a maximum of four (4) hours or as approved by the Engineer

In addition to the water line materials specified under Section 1036, the water line can be High Density Polyethylene (HDPE) pipe conforming to AWWA C906 with an SDR of 9 and pressure rating of 200 psi working pressure.

II. COMPENSATION:

No direct payment will be made for utility construction work required by the preceding provisions, which are general requirements applying to utility construction, and all of the requirements stated will be considered incidental work, paid for at the contract unit prices of the various utility items included in the contract.
